CONSUMER TIPS:

Insist On Certification -

Before signing a contract make sure that it says, "The crew leader for this installation will be NABCEP Certified."



Only those individuals who have earned NABCEP Certification can display this logo. Look for this logo and a name and/or certification number below the logo.

Check Other Credentials -

Make sure that the contractor holds all other trade qualifications, licenses, and permits that are required to perform solar installations in your jurisdiction.

Ask for References

Contact at least two recent references provided by the contractor and get their feedback.
