For the sake of all visitors and to protect our collections, please follow these guidelines:

- Leave weapons and tools in your vehicle.
- Leave pets outside; qualified service dogs are welcome.
- Allow us to inspect bags and briefcases as you enter and exit.
- Wear appropriate attire, including shirt and shoes.

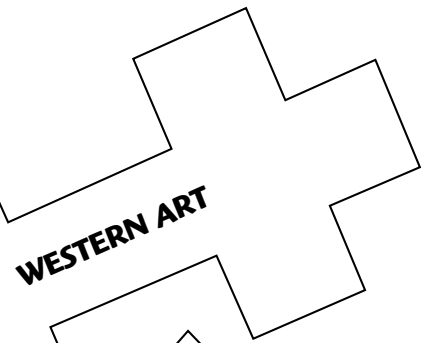
