## **Assistive Technology**

Are you looking to support a loved one without being invasive and without having to be there

24/7 "just in case" there's a need? SimplyHome systems give individuals independence for as long as possible, while giving family members and caregivers peace of mind. The SimplyHome system creates a virtual living environment to track specific activities within the home. The system then reports those activities to designated family members or caregivers through alerts and the SimplyHome Web Portal.



Each system is tailored to the individual. With the use of discrete sensors throughout the home, the SimplyHome system is programmed to respond when there is a problem. The system instantly sends alerts to designated family, friends, caregivers, case managers or other professionals via email and/or cell phone call or text message according to each individual's specific rules. Our "Up & About" and "Exception Data" features send an alert if a sensor does NOT sense activity during a designated time; i.e. 9 a.m. to 12 noon.

## What Are Your Concerns?


**Falls-** Each year, one in every three adults age 65 and older falls. The system can alert others automatically within minutes **without** the press of a button.

**Cooking-** The stove sensor can distinguish whether an individual is actively cooking or has stepped away and forgotten the stove was on.

**Medication-** A medicine cabinet sensor or dispenser can generate a friendly reminder to a loved one to take their medication and alert someone accordingly if their medication was not taken.

**Wellness-** Weight, blood pressure, and glucose readings can be tracked automatically using off the shelf devices.

Mother was also prone to getting blood clots. The system would alert me via text message if she had not left her chair in more than 2 hours.
