Q. What is Distance Education?

Distance education is a flexible way to earn your high school diploma. As a James Madison student, you'll receive your coursework online, so you can study whenever you want while receiving the personal support you need to succeed. Best of all, JMHS is extremely affordable. Without all the overhead costs of a traditional high school, your education dollars go even further.

Q. What is homeschooling?

Homeschooling is a legal option for parents wanting to provide their children with a different learning environment than exists in nearby schools. To support this alternate learning method, James Madison High School provides a high quality curriculum, grading/feedback, tutoring support, an interactive community, and an accredited high school diploma.

Q. Why should I pursue my high school diploma now?
