Program Locations

Every year we add more countries in order to give you more choices. At our program locations, many local people live on less than \$1 a day and they are in desperate need of international volunteers.

Start Date and Duration

• You can start your program any week of the year (with advanced notice). You can volunteer for periods of 1 week to 6 months. You may also extend your stay with advanced notice.

Personal Spending

• As food and accommodation are both included, you don't need to expect to spend much money at all. Many volunteers find \$30 is more than enough for weekly personal expense, but this figure can vary largely depending on your personal spending habit.

Program Requirements

- You can apply online on your own if you are 18 years or over at the start of the program. For participants who are 16-17 years old at the start of the program, you can join if the parent or legal guardian gives permission and signs our waiver form.
- You must be able to speak English. (For programs in Latin America, basic Spanish skills are strongly recommended.)
- Medical placement volunteers must have relevant medical training and certification (to be presented upon arrival), but no previous training is required to help medical professionals.
