"The voice quality is important in helping me listen," she comments. "Since I use it everyday, I need to have a voice that actually sounds interesting, so I recommend that you choose a voice you like that sounds pleasant." Pam's listening preference is for a female, U.S. English voice from among *TextAloud*'s many optional Premium Voices available for purchase and download. "It was worth it to get a voice I liked," she comments. "It makes the listening process easier and ensures that I keep my focus on editing."

TextAloud is now a regular part of Pam's work routine and proofing method, enabling her to edit her work more easily, and to feel confident that everything is correct each time she completes a new transcription.
