





Eastern NC An Assessment

Biomedical, scientific, and mathematically based industries are the fastest-growing and most promising areas for economic development. Enticing these industries to relocate to eastern North Carolina requires a workforce that is "literate" in science and mathematics.

that the knowledge of science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and medicine

(STEM2) is a core understanding and capacity of an educated community.

Academic performance in science and mathematics in North Carolina indicates a critical need for intervention. Statistics show that only 1 in 3 NC 8th graders are proficient in mathematics and only 1 in 5 are proficient in science. Over 62% of currently available jobs require STEM skills; however, only 21% of students graduate with those skills. Our students are not prepared for the jobs of today or tomorrow.

GO-Science has been serving Eastern North Carolina for over 10 years. Anually, we reach over 20 thousand participants with on-site and online programming.

GO-Science has a collection of over 12 core programs that are currently being delivered to over 29 counties throughout Eastern North Carolina.

Our most popular programs include science cafes, green drinks, the regional science fair, a planetarium outreach program, and summer science camps.

In addition, we have the only digital 3D science center available in North Carolina via SecondLife. We also utilize our technology systems to connect our rural region with the EduNET collaboration system for STEM leaders as well as matching students throughout the region with online science mentors through our STEMnet mentor system.
