The Court of Appeals “distilled” prior case law in McLean v. NYC to restate (many say expand) the doctrine of governmental immunity. Despite three recent Court of Appeals’ decisions clarifying this doctrine, and the related “public duty rule,” lower courts continue to engage in the common law process of defining the contours of the doctrine to specific contexts. Colby will look at recent developments in this area of the law to see how the doctrine is being applied in the Appellate Division.
