

## **Players and Fans Gearing Up as Fantasy Baseball 2013 Season Slated to Begin March 31st**

The start of the new Major League Baseball season is now less than two weeks away. While players and teams are gearing up for the new campaign in Spring Training, fans are pouring over fantasy baseball rankings in order to get ready for their drafts. The new season will begin when the Texas Rangers take on the Houston Astros on Sunday, March 31<sup>st</sup>. The contest will mark Houston’s first as the newest member of the American League West.

“Houston’s move to the American League is important for a number of reasons,” said Worth. “All teams will now play 20 Interleague games throughout the regular season. When and where the Interleague games are played could have a big impact on some fantasy baseball 2013 players.”

The three players at the top of nearly all of the fantasy baseball rankings are Milwaukee Brewers outfielder Ryan Braun, Detroit Tigers third baseman Miguel Cabrera and Los Angeles Angels outfielder Mike Trout.

Braun hit .319 with 41 homers and 112 RBI last season. Cabrera became the first player to win the Triple Crown since 1967 after hitting .330 with 44 homers and 139 RBI. Trout took home AL Rookie of the Year honors after batting .326 with 30 homers, 129 runs, 49 stolen bases and 83 RBI.

In addition to the fantasy baseball 2013 draft sheets, Printable Brackets has released a special MLB Picks Pool for the 2013 season. The pool includes all 30 MLB teams and runs throughout the entire upcoming season.

“The MLB Picks Pool is a unique way to follow the sport all season long,” said Worth. “The pool is just another thing that gives you the ability to put your baseball acumen to the test against your friends and co-workers. Much like with fantasy baseball, this is a great way to get more involved with the game you already love.”
