On the wooded hillside banks overlooking the Cottonwood River in New Ulm, Minnesota, the August Schell Brewing Company has been quietly crafting a family of fine specialty beers since 1860.

Schell's Goosetown is named after a neighborhood located across the tracks and down by the Minnesota River in New Ulm, where mostly Catholic German-Bohemian immigrants began settling in the late 1800s. These immigrants kept and raised gaggles of geese, which wandered freely throughout the neighborhood and fed along the banks of the river.

This beer is our interpretation of a traditional, German-style Gose. It has a bright lemon zest and coriander aroma with a slight saltiness reminiscent of a cool ocean breeze. Lighter bodied, yet full flavored with lively carbonation that gives the beer a crisp, dry finish. A uniquely refreshing session beer, perfectly suited for a warm summer day from the August Schell Brewing Company.
