- 3 An unidentified DNA profile , consistent with a mixture, was obtained from the swabs of the knit hat (Item Q1).

The above bracketed alleles from the swabs of the knit hat (Item Q1) were searched against the state DNA database. No additional investigative leads were established as a result of this search. Upload of this unidentified DNA profile into CODIS is dependent upon the receipt of a suspect standard and/or elimination standard. If a direct DNA comparison is desired, please submit a blood sample in a lavender top tube or a buccal collector from the individual to the laboratory.

Additional minor/less intense alleles were also present in genetic loci TH01, D21S11, D18S51, D5S818, D7S820, CSF1PO, Penta D, and D8S1179. No further interpretation could be made due to an insufficient amount of DNA from this minor component.

The unidentified individual obtained from the hairs from the knit hat (Item Q2) cannot be excluded as a potential contributor to this DNA mixture profile.

Tahir Gardner (Item K1) cannot be included as a contributor to this DNA mixture profile.

- 4 A DNA profile from an unidentified individual was obtained from the hairs from the knit hat (Item Q2).

This unidentified DNA profile, consistent with a male, was searched against CODIS at the above mentioned loci. No investigative leads were established as a result of this search.

This unidentified DNA profile has been uploaded to CODIS and future searches will be conducted on a weekly basis as additional profiles are entered into CODIS. If an investigative lead is established, a supplemental report will be issued. If a direct DNA comparison is desired, please submit a blood sample in a lavender top tube or a buccal collector from the individual to the laboratory.

Tahir Gardner (Item K1) does not match the DNA profile obtained from the hairs from the knit hat (Item Q2).
