- CG: I am going to ask Col King, PM, to set up the physical arrangements. How can he get in touch with you?
- Mr B: My telephone is Albuquerque 2470311, Ext 2243. This may come as a surprise, but the U. S. Attorneys have instructed that if anything is recovered, they will seize it all until everything is settled.
- CG: I wanted someone from the Treasury Dept to take custody. You will get a call from Col King right away. We are planning to set up something for this weekend.

The CG called Col King this date:

CG: I got a call from Pat Boggs about 1350 (CG gave Col King his telephone).

Col K: I know him. Does he know anything about this?

CG: I think he knows the whole works. He informed me that the U. S. Attorney had said anything recovered would be turned over to him. I told him we are thinking about sometime this weekend and that you would call him today.

Col K: Do you prefer a weekend?

- CG: Yes, they were thinking about getting in there wik when there was nothing going on on the Range. You know, Garman is personally involved in this.
- Col K: The reason I asked, I had scheduled a trip to Alpine. If it is allright, Kelly can take it.
- CG: That is fine. Get in touch with Boggs and get the thing lined up and let me know and I will then call Garman.

Col Garman called the CG regarding another subject (separate memo) and the CG told him what had transpired and that he would contact Garman as soon as a time had been set.
