# 3 Months Before You Go \_\_\_\_ Start daydreaming about where you'd like to go. \_\_\_\_ Buy "Planning Road Trips" book from Amazon.com \_\_\_\_ Buy roadside attraction apps, park guides. Buy phrase books or language guide apps. \_\_\_\_ Research monuments, attractions and parks online. Define the purpose of your trip (visit, attractions, roaming). \_\_\_\_ Decide where you want to go if time limited vacation. Use Google Maps to calculate the driving distances. Buy GPS unit, or GPS software and practice using it. Arrange annual vacation time, or leave of absence from work. \_\_\_\_ Arrange for an elderly care giver or live-in assistant for parents. \_\_\_\_ Renew the passport if not six months remaining. \_\_\_\_ Get a second credit card, from another vendor, as a back up. Visit the doctor for travel vaccinations and medications. \_\_\_\_ Obtain any visitor visas required by destination countries. Get child consent letter (Your right to accompany them). \_\_ Get an eye exam and update prescription eyewear. Scan important documents into your computer. \_\_\_\_ Make photocopies of important documents, if no scanner. \_\_\_\_ (See the Documents Packing List at PlanningRoadTrips.com) 1 Month Before You Go Join the local auto club AAA or CAA. Get an international drivers license if required. Arrange pet care or accommodations. \_\_\_ Go to the dentist for checkup and cleaning. \_\_\_\_ Notify the day care, school, etc, of away time. \_\_\_\_ Arrange for a housesitter and emergency contact. \_\_\_\_ Create a budget for the trip, if money is tight. Calculate your car's gas usage to budget accordingly.

# 1 Week Before You Go \_\_\_\_ Do a visual inspection of car tires and engine. Get the routine car maintenance done. Get a fresh can of tire puncture sealant to fix flats. \_\_\_\_ Get any windshield chips or cracks fixed. Prepare the emergency kit (Emergency Kit Checklist) Prepare the first aid kit (First Aid Kit Checklist) Research the attractions you want to see. Plan your final itinerary for time limited vacations. Get spare home keys made. \_\_\_\_ Put valuables in safety deposit box. Buy automatic light timers and learn to use them. Buy security locks for sliding doors and windows. \_\_\_\_ Enter important phone numbers into mobile. \_\_\_\_ Enter medical info into cell phone notes. \_\_\_\_ Create encrypted drive or folder on computer. \_\_\_\_ Put all important scans, docs into encrypted drive. Pick up any dry cleaning, tailoring, etc. \_\_\_\_ Check memory cards and batteries for electronics. \_\_\_\_ Tell neighbor you trust about the vacation. \_\_\_\_ Remind the housesitter and emergency contact. \_\_\_\_ Notify credit card companies of your itinerary. 1 - 2 Days Before You Go Take out cash at ATM and have at least 200 on hand. Check bank account balances and transfer funds. Pay all monthly bills, if auto payment not used.

\_\_\_\_ Pay utility bills in advance if leaving for a long time.

Clean out the car interior of non essentials.Load the "stay in the car" items into the car.

Get changed into your comfy driving clothes Listen for traffic closures and road conditions.
Do one last visual inspection of the car. Set up the GPS on the mount in the car. Do quick perimeter check around yard.
Fill up water jugs and bottles. Empty, clean and put away water filter.

Use a hands free device if talking while driving.  Take turns driving if one of you feels tired or dizzy.
