



HOW PROXTOME WORKS

When users start ProxToMe, the app automatically shows the contact list including all Facebook friends and ProxToMe contacts. Users can interact with anyone from the contact list. With ProxToMe, anybody with a Facebook profile and a friendship, can receive a message from a ProxToMe user. Even more: they can reply via Facebook chat but cannot send files.

With ProxToMe users can send photos and videos stored into the smartphone or made on-the-go plus any file stored into their Dropbox account. At first content send/receive, ProxToMe requires for linking Dropbox. Even though Dropbox default disclaimer is broad (and a little bit scary), ProxToMe does not access, read and modify any file. Users only can access their files as account owner. Should users be new on Dropbox, ProxToMe allows for creating a new Dropbox account in few seconds.

When the users want to interact with people nearby (e.g. a work meeting, a party, a gig, during some free time at the park) they can open the "Nearby" screen to automatically run the proximity engine and detect other users. As people pop up, users can instantly chat and share files with them without the need for friending them.

Users can use the proximity engine also to add new friends only, by tapping the icon on the right hand of each name.
