IFPTI EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SPEAK AT WESTERN ASSOCIATION OF FOOD AND DRUG OFFICIALS CONFERENCE

Presentation to Focus on the Integrated Food Safety System Toolkit

BATTLE CREEK, Mich. – Gerald Wojtala, executive director of the International Food Protection Training Institute (IFPTI), will speak at the Western Association of Food and Drug Officials (WAFDO) 2013 Annual Educational Conference in Portland, Oregon titled "Navigating the Waters of Change".

The three-day conference is scheduled for August 4-6 at the Red Lion Convention Center.

Wojtala will speak Monday, August 4 at 9:15 a.m. on the Integrated Food Safety System Toolkit. The session will cover how regulatory agencies and organizations can use the newly developed toolkit.

"The overall goal is to have a fully integrated food safety system," said Wojtala. "The toolkit will help organizations identify where they are in this process and then map out a strategy to move forward."
