Fluorescent tubes have dominated commercial illumination in American ceilings for more than 50 years – more than 2.3 billion tubes are installed, according to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). That installed base provides a huge potential retrofit market for solid state lighting and LED technology.

While both of ETi's DLC listed 4' linear tubes are 18 watts, the 1800 Lumen, CCT 4000K, 82 CRI 4' integral tube (Part number 54145041) delivers 100 Lumens per Watt and the 1900 Lumen, CCT 5000K, 83 CRI 4' integral tube (Part number 54145061) achieves 105 Lumens per Watt efficacy. Both products are a great solution for retrofitting existing fluorescent fixtures in industrial and commercial construction, meeting rooms, hotel/motel locations, offices, museums, galleries, shop windows, and restaurants.
