



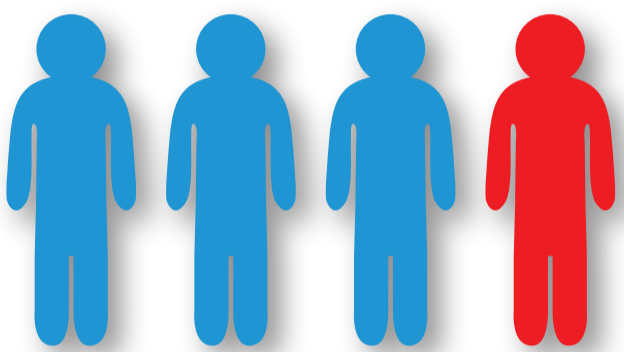
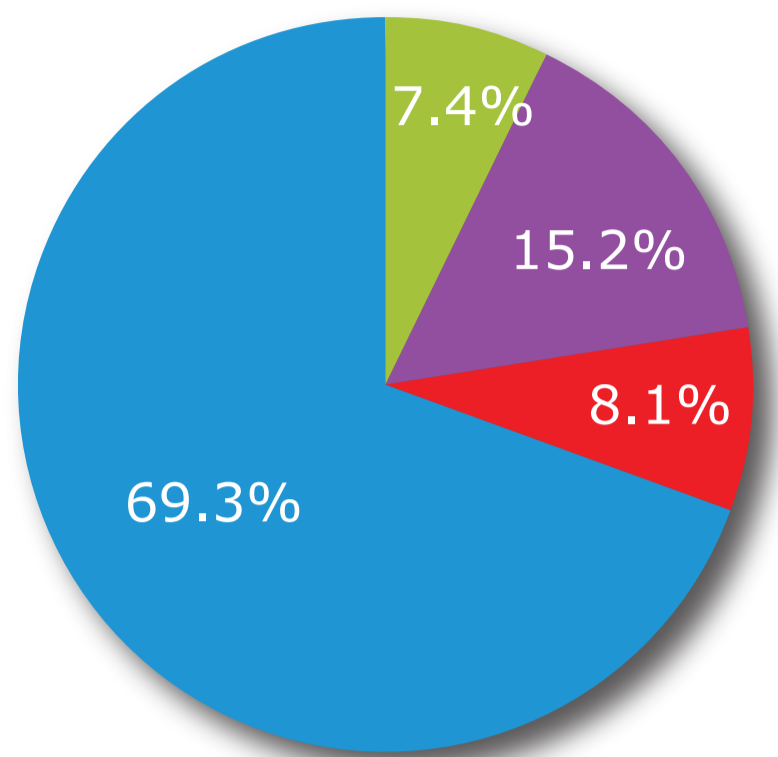


Most Teens Don't Drink Alcohol

-  No



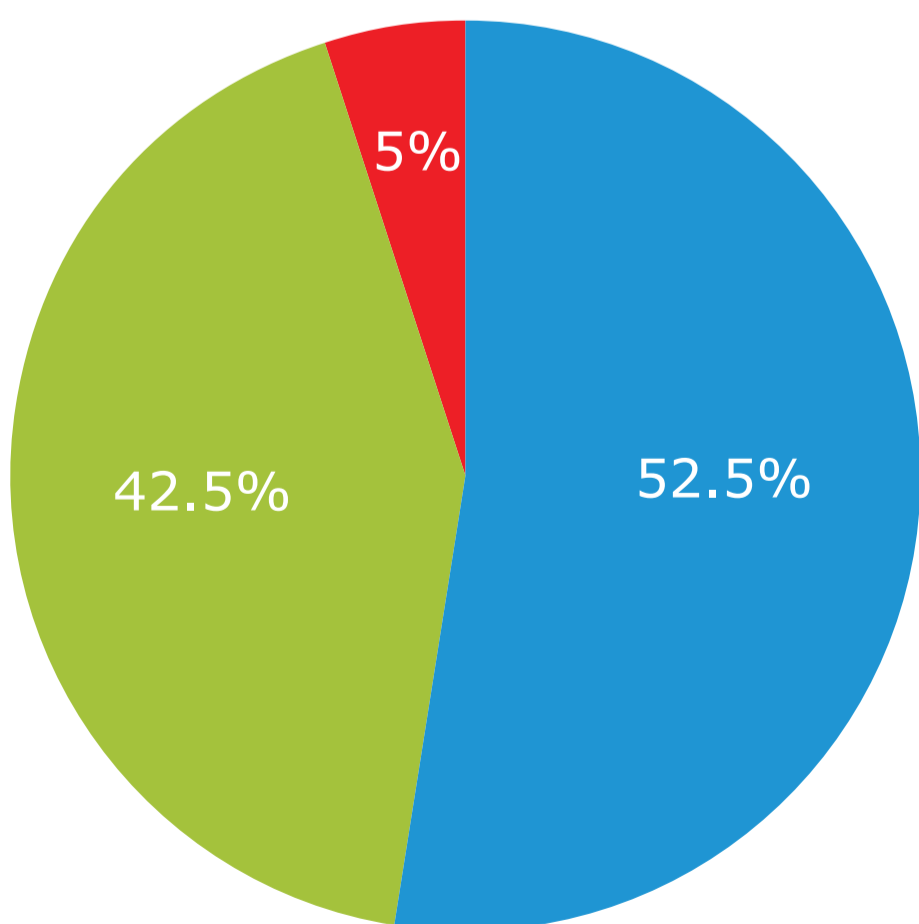
3 out of 4 high school students DON'T drink alcohol.

Top five reasons why teens choose not to drink:

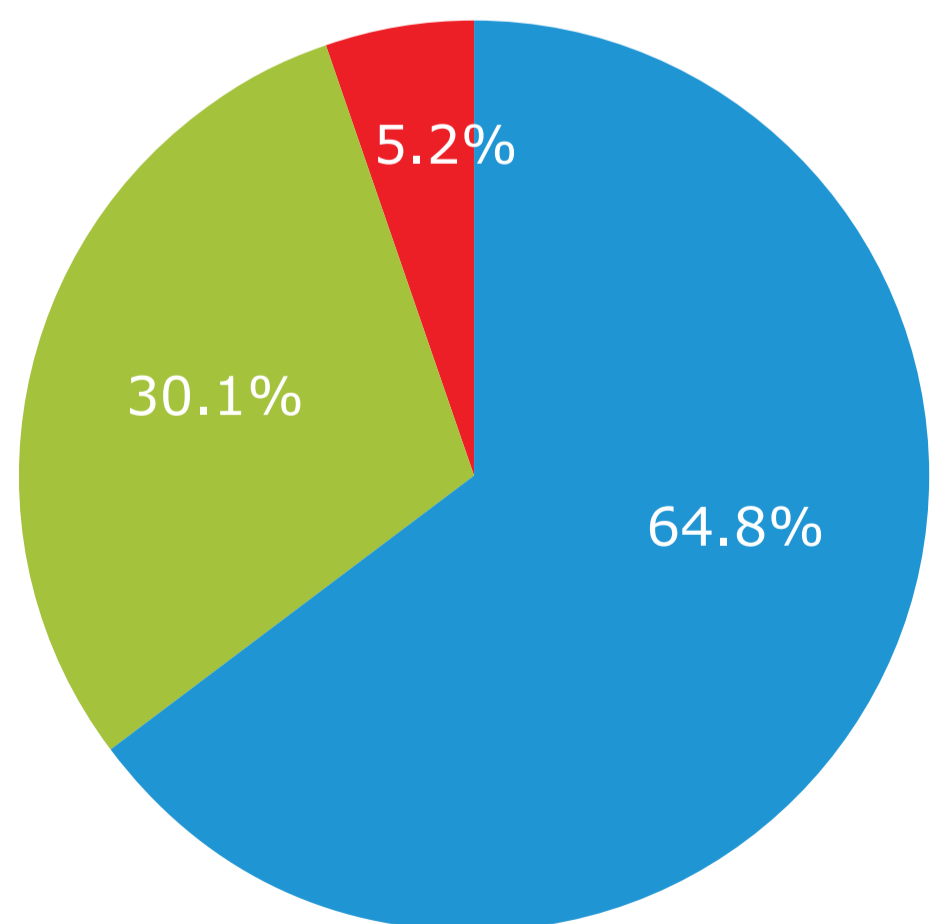
-  1. It's illegal
