



Through the Papers of William F. Cody, an archive of the life and times of an American icon-William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody (1846—1917)—readers are given glimpses of attitudes of the time through Cody's interactions with individuals ranging from statesmen and royalty to noted military and literary figures who sought his opinion on policy questions concerning the American West. A greater understanding of public attitudes and political, economic, and environmental policies that affected the United States during his lifetime are also reflected in his lesser-known roles as a community founder, businessman, rancher, and investor.
