The whole family (moms, dads, sisters, bothers) can all participate side by side in these customized versions of the Space Academy and the Advanced Space Academy programs.

Space Camp is the adventure of a lifetime! Our objective is to have Terra Scholars (homeschoolers) take over the entire Space Camp facility for 5 days and nights during which each camper will be able to:

- * Participate in two 1-hour simulated shuttle missions, with some students running mission control, while others handle operations in the shuttle and in the space station.
- * Experience astronaut training in the 1/6th gravity chair, the multi-axis trainer and other simulators including the centrifuge and flight simulators at the Aviation Challenge facilities.
- * Learn all about the space program, participate in team building exercises, learn about robotics with hands-on activities, engage in water activities and enjoy the night telescope.
- * Construct and fly rockets, get an astronaut's view of the Earth in the IMAX® Spacedome theater and learn leadership and teamwork skills at the Area 51 (Challenge Course).

There are two simultaneous programs designed for students of different age groups. They are:



SPACE ACADEMY (our version) is for ages 9-13 and parents who want to participate (This is a customized Space Academy program combined with elements of the Aviation Challenge and Robotics Programs).



ADVANCED SPACE ACADEMY is for Ages 14 & up including parents

(This is a customized Advanced Space Academy program combined with elements of the Aviation Challenge and Robotics Programs - Graduates receive 1 hour of college credit from the University of Alabama).



Both programs are priced at \$825.00. Each program includes all of the activities listed above, five nights of lodging in the space habitat, three meals a day, flight suit with leather name tag, clothing set (t-shirt, shorts, hooded sweatshirt, sweat pants and backpack), custom team patch and a custom Home Learning Association patch.

Underwater Astronaut Training (SCUBA) activities in the Camp's 24-foot-deep heated tank are available for a limited number of the Advanced Space Academy participants at an extra cost. Those who are interested should call 303-800-5774 or email us for
