Team Rubicon Serves a Dual Mission.

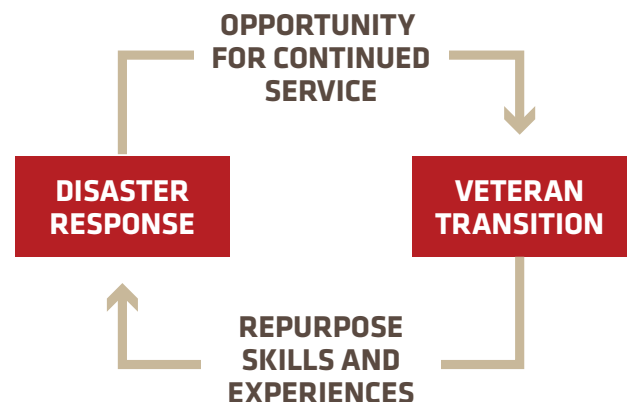

Team Rubicon challenges our veterans and first responders to continue their service, to forge a new brotherhood, and to find a new mission.”

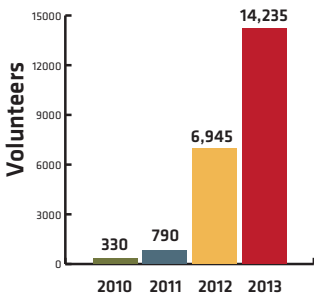

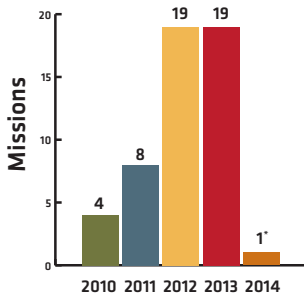
PAST MISSIONS
