Cosmetic <u>breast revision surgery</u> is one of those sub-specialties that requires literally years of experience for a surgeon to do a good job. Although breast revision surgery is becoming more common due to the very large number of patients who have undergone cosmetic breast surgery during last 40 years, complications requiring revision are seen in less than two percent of those patients. It takes a busy, successful surgeon with at least 20 years in practice to have seen and treated enough patients to gather the experience to be able to address most all of the problems one may see in a lifetime of surgical practice.

Dr. Moser, who has been performing cosmetic breast surgery since 1987, has seen almost every complication imaginable. Dr. Moser has gained an outstanding nationwide reputation for treating even the most severe cosmetic breast surgery complications. Many of Dr. Moser's cosmetic breast surgery peers have referred to him their most complicated cases from around the county. Dr. Moser is an active instructor for other surgeons wanting to learn both the art and science of cosmetic breast surgery in general and treatment of post-operative complications in particular.

Among the most common reasons for cosmetic breast revision surgery are:

- Implant Malposition
- Capsular Contracture
- Saline Breast Implant Leaking
- Silicone Breast Implant Rupture
- Breast Implant Rippling
- Breast Implant Infection
- Implants that are either too small or too large
- Continued breast tissue sagging after a lift or reduction
- Nipples in the wrong place after breast lift or reduction

Surgery is not an exact science and unforeseen complications may occur. Problems like deflation of saline implants or rupture of silicone implants or other medical complication are infrequent, but on

occasion they happen. If any problem arises, it is important to have a surgeon who stands with the patient and is willing to do what is necessary with a remedy.
