## Milgard Launches Bi-fold, Pocket options for Moving Glass Wall Systems

With Moving Glass Wall Systems, homeowners can enjoy a seamless transition from room to room or close off areas just as easily. Since large glass walls are often built into high-end houses, the product adds a touch of luxury to any home.
