-CONFERENCE-USA All-Freshman Team

U of MEMPHIS 2010-2011 -Selected by Phil Steele as a Freshman All-American -One of just six Tigers to start all 12 games. Became a solid leader in the secondary as a redshirt freshman surrounded by upperclassmen.

-Set a season-high, which he would ultimately tie two other times, with six tackles against East Carolina

-Registered his first career interception when he picked off MTSU's Logan Kilgore on a 3rd-and-5 situation from the Memphis 47 in the third quarter. Logged a 20yard return and put Memphis in a position to go ahead 24-10.

-Versus UTEP, tallied two pass breakups and an interception.

-Tied his season mark with six tackles against Tennessee. Four of the tackles were solo stops, and he also posted a pass breakup in the game.

-Ended the 2010 season ranked sixth on the team in tackles with 39. Was tied for the team lead in interceptions with two, and was second in passes defended with five. Worked some at safety in the spring.

Still playing in 12 games.</li> <li>-Senior year, Seisay was a swiss army knife player, being plugged in at starting cornerback, special teamer, nickleback, dime packages, safety.</li> <li>-Seisay was a standout special teams performer, and an intimidating presence on defense.</li> </ul>
PERSONAL/ HIGH SCHOOL	Seisay went to Fork Union Military Academy in Virginia, where he played for Coach John Shuman and helped the team to a 6-4 record. Seisay totaled 45 tackles and eight pass breakups for Fork Union, and also returned a blocked PAT 95 yards. Seisay also played for Coach Bill Renner at West Springfield (Va.) High School, where he helped the 2007 team to a 10-3 record and trip to the playoffs for the first time in 14 years. Seisay had 35 tackles, four interceptions, 10 pass breakups and forced one fumble in 2007, also had school-record three interceptions in one game. Seisay was named first-team all-district as a Junior and Senior.
