The Original Greenwich Village Food and Culture Walking Tour

Taste from classic mom-and-pop specialty food shops, ethnic eateries, and charming neighborhood restaurants along the winding streets of the West Village. Learn about the history, culture, architecture, and entertainment offerings that make Greenwich Village unique. Discover the old Italian neighborhood, **hidden gardens, the narrowest house in NYC**, and much more!

Central Greenwich Village Food and Culture Walking Tour

Discover a counter-cultural haven once enjoyed by bohemians, beatniks, artists, and folk singers. Relish in the rich and varied history of the vibrant and intriguing neighborhood in the heart of the Village. Enjoy a stroll through **Washington Square Park, view architecture from the 19th century, discover the best venues for live music and comedy**, and sample a scrumptious variety of food specialties from unique and diverse ethnic eateries and restaurants.

Chelsea Market / Meatpacking District Food and Culture Walking Tour

Become a Chelsea Market insider—experience the sights, sounds, and flavors of the historic **112-year-old landmark building, the birthplace of the Oreo Cookie**. Uncover the history of the Market, view original artwork and granite sculptures, and taste your way through the ultimate indoor food paradise. Finish the tour with a walk down the trendy **Highline promenade**, wander through the Meatpacking District, and learn how this seedy neighborhood transformed into one of the chicest spots in the city.

Nolita / NoHo Food and Culture Walking Tour

Weave your way through the cozy corners of Nolita, where old-world charm meets a youthful, downtown vibe. Taste mouthwatering eats from undiscovered spots that specialize in traditional recipes and century-old techniques. **Walk the same streets as John Gotti and Martin Scorsese while visiting sites made famous by *The Godfather***. Learn about the colorful history of The Bowery (the original theatre district) and explore its dark and animated past. Formerly known for flophouses, Skid Row bums, and the legendary CBGB's music venue, Nolita has transformed into a mecca for posh hotels and delectable dining.

Chinatown Food and Culture Walking Tour

Discover the authentic cuisine, history, and culture of New York City's Chinatown. Explore historic landmarks and the hidden side streets of this **small, bustling district that is home to the largest concentration of Chinese people in the Western Hemisphere**. Dine in three exquisite Chinese restaurants and enjoy regional Chinese cuisine—from dumplings to peking duck—while observing the traditional etiquette that is partnered with these fine foods.
