The Company

Bonnie Castle Resort is located on the St. Lawrence River in Alexandria Bay, NY. It features a resort, marina, conference and banquet hall space and three restaurants.

The Challenge

Bonnie Castle Resort retained SmartWatt, via National Grid's Small Business Services Program, to conduct an energy audit of all lighting systems at its marina in Alexandria Bay, NY, for potential energy-saving upgrades. SmartWatt engineered a plan to replace the existing lighting systems with energy-efficient fluorescent and LED lighting fixtures throughout interior and exterior areas. The goals of the owners were to improve the overall appearance of the marina, increase the quality and quantity of light and to save money on energy costs.

Smart Savings

In addition to improved building appearance, Bonnie Castle Resort will enjoy the following realized energy savings from this lighting upgrade project:

- Monthly Energy Savings: \$310
- Payback Period: 10 months

National Grid Rebate: \$7,474
