MATH

Each summer camper will work on 45 minutes of math a day. Every camper will work on FUN math review, games, etc. and will focus on any “holes” in his/her basic math skill set. Our summer camp math program will use innovative ways to keep math fresh in a student’s mind.

LANGUAGE ARTS

Each summer camper will work on 45 minutes of Language Arts a day using the POWER PROCESS of writing (Plan, Organize, Write, Edit, Revise). Additionally, campers will work on Grammar, Reading Comprehension, and Vocabulary building activities according to grade level appropriateness.
