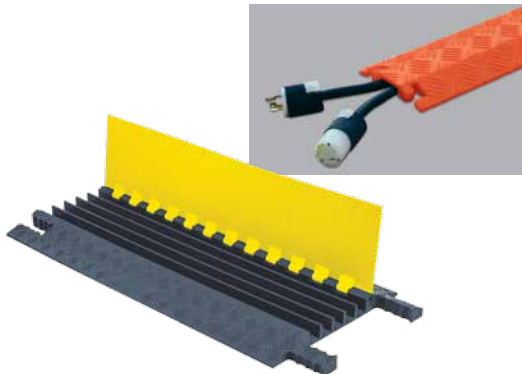
TRAFFIC CONES AND DELINEATORS
