

Featuring New Yorker staff cartoonist Roz Chast

New Yorker cartoonist Roz Chast, a brilliant interpreter of the everyday, makes us laugh—then wince. This year's featured speaker will talk about her remarkable career as a cartoonist and her new graphic memoir, Can't We Talk about Something More Pleasant, which brings her signature wit to the topic of aging parents. With cartoons and family photos, she creates a touching portrait of two lives at their end and an only child coping as best she can during her parents' shift from independence to dependence. "I wrote this book to help others in the same situation," she said.

Roz Chast grew up in Brooklyn and received a BFA in 1977 from Rhode Island School of Design. In 1978, she became one of the youngest staff cartoonists at *The New Yorker*, which has continually published her work for 34 years. She has provided cartoons for some 50 magazines and has written or illustrated more than a dozen books.
