## **History:**

Upon his discovery of aquaponics from a family friend, Jack Ikard knew he had developed a new passion. After graduating and moving into a small apartment for college, Jack had to find a way to bring aquaponics with him. In early-2013, using only his ambition and a laser cutter, Jack created and designed an indoor aquaponics system that works in harmony with standard 10-gallon aquariums. To take his idea to the next level, Jack brought together a passionate design & marketing team and collaborated with a local manufacturing company that boasts over 25 years of retail design and manufacturing experience.

Before he knew it, Jack's backyard idea quickly sprouted into today's sleek AquaSprouts Garden.

## **AquaSprouts Garden:**

- Garden is made out of matte black polycarbonate
- Garden fits over any standard 10-gallon aguarium (20" x 10" x 12")
- Grow-bed consists of non-degradable, terracotta clay pebbles
- Grow-bed can easily accommodate plants such as lettuce, strawberries, dwarf cherry tomatoes, basil, mint, wheatgrass, spinach, and peppers
- Aquarium can use common freshwater pet fish
- Removable Light Bar included to aid plant growth
- Select award tiers include an education kit featuring an educational curriculum provided by The Aquaponic Source
- Box includes Garden, Light Bar, Pump + Timer, Clay Pebbles, and (on select award tiers) 10-gallon aquarium and/or aquaponics education kit
