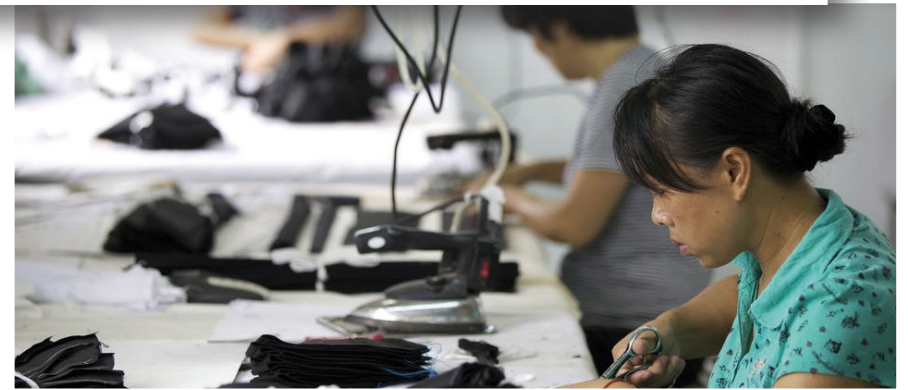
About Vision Textiles

Steps of the Recycling Process

Textile products made from recycled plastic bottles.

1

The plastic bottles are stripped of caps and labels and cleaned



2

They are processed into flakes and washed



3

The clean flakes are transformed into chips



4

Yarn is pulled from the melted chips



5

100% recycled polyester yarn can be used directly or blended with other eco-friendly yarns to produce Waste2Wear[®] fabrics



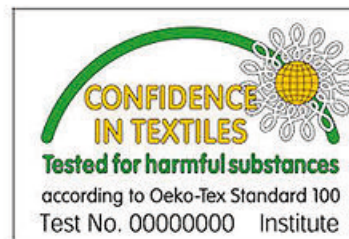
