PERKINS EASTMAN CELEBRATES RIBBON CUTTING OF THE SPRINGS AT MONARCH LANDING, NEW HEALTH AND REHAB CENTER IN NAPERVILLE, IL

Designed on a Residential Household Model, The Springs Offers Much Needed Specialized Care for Seniors in the Chicago Area

New York, NY (October 8, 2014) Just under a year and a half since the project broke ground, members from the Chicago office of Perkins Eastman joined Monarch Landing last week in Naperville, IL to cut the ceremonial ribbon for The Springs, the senior living community's new 94,000 sf Health and Rehabilitation Center. The Springs comprises numerous private resident rooms and couples' suites, with 48 devoted to short-term rehabilitation, 48 to skilled care, and 28 for assisted living memory support. Other building amenities include a physical therapy suite, salon, café, multi-purpose room, outdoor gardens and courtyards, as well as covered access from the existing independent living buildings.

The Springs at Monarch Landing introduces one of only a few neighborhood household models for seniors to the Chicago area, specially designed to provide a continuum of care as well as provide optimal living space for residents suffering from dementia. The Perkins Eastman design team worked closely with Senior Care Development and Monarch Landing leadership throughout, from developing the multi-phase master plan for the entire 15-acre campus right down to the interior architecture of The Springs. When brought together, the Health Center's design aesthetic emphasizes an inviting and comfortable setting with clean, modern lines and earthen tones, all situated amidst an expansive yet intimate natural landscape with gardens, courtyards and walking paths.

"There is a growing demand on a global scale among senior living providers for more 'person-centered care' household models," says Design Principal Jerry Walleck AIA, who attended the ribbon cutting ceremony along with other team members. "It enables communities to provide a better and more humane level of care, and market themselves better to future residents. And yet, relatively few have instituted these types of communities. The Springs at Monarch Landing now stands apart, and we're quite proud to have played a hand in designing this community."
