

# University of Vermont Health Network

The University of Vermont Health Network was founded in October 2011 under the name Fletcher Allen Partners with an affiliation between Fletcher Allen Health Care and Central Vermont Medical Center.

In January 2013, CVPH Medical Center in Plattsburgh and Elizabethtown Community Hospital in Elizabethtown, New York joined the network through their parent company, Community Providers, Inc.

All four hospital organizations have transferred certain governance powers to the network Board of Trustees, formally linking them together under the parent organization.

On November 12, 2014, the partnership's name officially changed to The University of Vermont Health Network and three of the Partner hospitals - Central Vermont Medical Center, CVPH Medical Center and Elizabethtown Community Hospital - have added that to their existing names. Fletcher Allen Health Care changed its name to The University of Vermont Medical Center.
