


Well, the world's largest supercomputer has a data storage capacity of 500PB. 375PB of data is equal to:

ATG Clearinghouse uses a hash encryption for every Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) to mask ownership until the fleet owner's consent is received. Even ATG doesn't know what vehicle is being referenced when an insurer's request for data comes in.





By the end of 2016, the ATG Clearinghouse will provide access to data from over **25%** of all commercially insured vehicles (potentially **6 million** or more).
