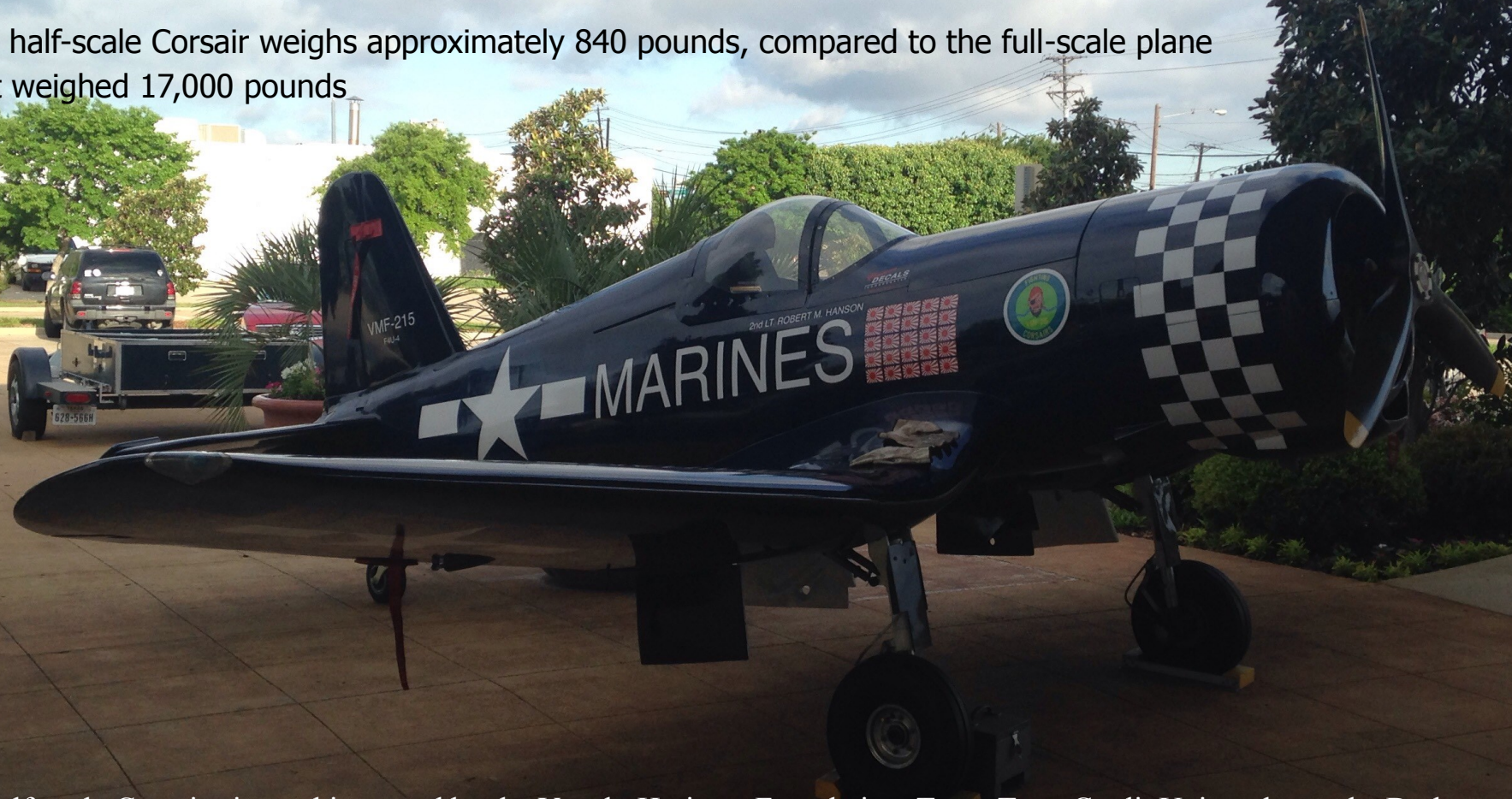


The Half-scale Corsair

- ◆ The replica of the F4U Corsair is half of the plane's original size, with full instrumentation; it is 16.5 feet long with a 21-foot wingspan
- ◆ With its 100 HP Continental engine, it can be flown
- ◆ The half-scale Corsair is smaller than a Cessna or Piper Cub. It was built after WWII and was never involved in combat
- ◆ The half-scale Corsair weighs approximately 840 pounds, compared to the full-scale plane that weighed 17,000 pounds



The half-scale Corsair pictured is owned by the Vought Heritage Foundation. Texas Trust Credit Union donated a Dodge Ram 1500 dual cab truck to the Foundation to transport the plane to events such as air shows and parades. The plane is used to educate the public about the history of the Corsair and about Vought's role in the aerospace industry.
