- Children's Miracle Network Hospitals is a charity that raises funds and awareness for 170 children's hospitals across the U.S. and Canada.
 - Children's hospitals rely on community donations to provide crucial services.
 - Donations stay local for hospitals to use them however they're needed most — typically for critical treatments and services, medical equipment, research and charitable care.
 - U.S. member hospitals provide \$3.4 billion in charitable care annually.
