

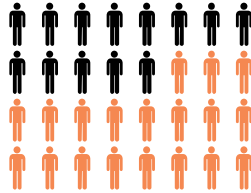

The Professional Private industry makes up 45% of all resources available for use by the agencies in wildland fire response nation wide.

Nationally there are 11300 private firefighters, and nationally the USFS has 10,000 firefighters. Many state agencies also have seasonal firefighters (exp. Oregon has 500 Seasonal).

90% of all private hand crews are based out of Oregon -

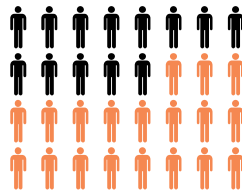
171 Type 2 Hand Crews under Interagency Agreement managed by Oregon Department of Forestry - That is 3420 firefighters.

37 Type 2 Initial Attack Self Sufficient Hand Crews on National Contract out of National Interagency Fire Center

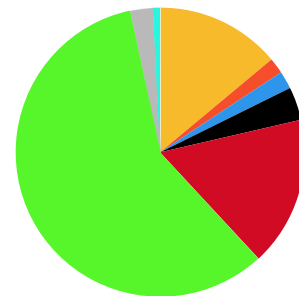
77%
