Graduate Assistantships and Fellowships

Graduate Assistantships, Graduate Teaching Assistantships, and Graduate Teaching Fellowships are competitively awarded to graduate students who demonstrate potential in their selected field of study. Awards range from \$4,500 for 10-hr/week assistantships to \$11,000 plus 9 graduate credits of tuition per semester for Graduate Teaching Fellows. All Graduate Teaching Assistantships and Fellowships provide stipends and at least partial tuition scholarships. A limited number of out-of-state tuition waivers are competitively awarded to Graduate Teaching Assistants and Fellows. A non-Virginia resident may potentially receive an award of over \$25,000 through a combination of tuition and stipend awards.
