Holly Rock Tree House Opens at Country Road Cabins

Guests have easy access to the tree house by a cable bridge from the nearby hillside.

The Holly Rock Tree House is a wonderfully unique lodging option:

- 24 feet in diameter and anchored 15 feet above the ground around a 75 foot tall 21" diameter Chestnut Oak tree
- A 37-foot cable bridge leads you to double French doors and into your deluxe, above ground haven.
- Expansive windows and a wraparound deck let you observe nature up close and personal while you relax and listen to nature's soundtrack
- Features a bathroom with hot shower and towels, queen-sized bed with linens, ultra high inverter heating/cooling system, a small refrigerator, sink, 2-burner hot plate, coffee pot, toaster oven, microwave, kitchenware, and a large screen TV/DVD with Dish Network.
- Extra amenities include: coffee, filters, sugar, creamer and paper products for your convenience

Nearby adventures and activities include:

- New River and Gauley River world class white water rafting area
- Tree Tops on the Gorge and Gravity zip lines
- Hiking, mountain biking, rappelling and rock climbing, motorcycle touring, fishing and nearby Summersville Lake
- Only 10 minutes from the world famous New River Gorge Bridge, a work of structural art and the longest steel span in the western hemisphere and the third highest in the United States.




Where is Country Road Cabins in Hico, West Virginia?


Holly Rock Tree House Floor Plan Layout

17 Log Cabins, 1 Wilderness Yurt, and 1 Holly Rock Tree House





IMPORTANT

**IF USING YAHOO, MAPQUEST OR GPS DIRECTIONAL WEBSITES PLEASE REMEMBER YOU HAVE TO COME TO THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 19 AND ROUTE 60 AT HICO.

There is a New River Exxon Gas/Convenience Service Center at this intersection and Sunday Road is directly across from this gas station. Our cabins are located approx. 2 miles down Sunday Road on the right. Directional signs direct you to each individual cabin. **When driving to our area especially on Route 19 North or South, it is heavily patrolled. Watch your speed through all the small towns of Summersville, Fayetteville, Oak Hill, etc. so you won't have to contribute to the local economy through speeding tickets!

Day time Check in hours for CRC are any time after 4:00 daily. On your arrival date if you plan to check in after 5:00 please let us know so that we can make arrangements for an after hours check in.

SUGGESTED ROUTES FROM CHARLESTON, WV TO HICO:

There are 2 routes available depending on which type roads you are more comfortable driving on.

1st OPTION: (2 lane road, some mountainous, curvy sections near Hawk's Nest State Park). Follow I-77/I-64 through Charleston to Belle US Route 60 East Exit #96 (Midland Trail). Follow US 60 E. approx 65 minutes to Hico, WV. Turn left on Sunday Road (just across from the New River Exxon Gas/Convenience Center).

2nd OPTION: (Mostly 4 lane road, only 8 miles of 2 lane roads). Stay on I-77/I-64 until Exit 60 at Mossy/Oak Hill or Route 612. Stay on this 2 lane Route 612 for approx. 8 miles until reaching Route 19 North. Turn left onto Route 19 North and go approx. 15 miles until Route 60 West exit at Hico. Proceed to New River Exxon Gas/Convenience Center and turn right onto Sunday Road.

From the North off I-79:

Follow I-79 South to exit 57 or Route 19 South toward Summersville, Beckley. Stay on Route 19 South approx. 45 miles to US Route 60 West exit at Hico. Proceed to the New River Exxon Gas/Convenience Center in the distance and turn right onto Sunday Road.

From the South off I-77N:

Just past Beckley, WV take Exit 48 Route 19 North toward Summersville. Follow Route 19 North approx. 23 miles to Route 60 West Exit. Proceed to New River Exxon Gas Center and turn right onto Sunday Road.

From I-64 E.

Just past Lewisburg, WV take exit 156 or Route 60 West at Sam Black Church. Follow Route 60 West approx 34 miles to Hico. Turn right onto Sunday Road across from the New River Gas/Convenience Center.
