The Bethesda Blues and Jazz Supper Club, once The Bethesda Theater, was built in 1938 and opened as one of the era's Art Deco cinema palaces. With an \$8 million renovation, the National Historic Register Property has been restored and is now the region's leading live music supper club. Since its opening in 2013, the club has hosted more than 500 artists, 170,000 customers, and 100 private events.
