WHAT WE CARE ABOUT: DOG SAFETY

According to the ASPCA, an unrestrained dog — whether curled up on a lap, hanging out the window or resting its paws on the steering wheel — can be deadly. Tens of thousands of car accidents are believed caused every year by unrestrained pets, though no one has solid numbers.

What is certain is that dogs must be secure in the car at all times — to prevent driver distraction and keep everyone, including your dogs, safe.

Crash Test Approved

Crash tests were conducted in June 2015 on the TLC-2X at the MGA crash test facility in Manassas, Virginia.

The K9 CarFence TLC-2X passed both the 25lb and 45lb 23g crash test with dummy dogs at 30mph.

WHY IS IT SO IMPORTANT TO KEEP DOGS SAFE AND SECURE IN THE CAR?

Here are a few facts from the ASPCA and AAA:

- In a crash, an unrestrained pet can turn into a deadly projectile or get crushed by a driver or passenger who is thrown forward by the collision.
- A pet that weighs 50 pounds, in a 35 mph collision, is projected forward like a cannonball with 1,500 pounds of force, and that can cause critical injuries to the folks in the front seat.
- Restraining a pet also keeps the animal from running off after a crash and possibly getting hit or causing another crash, or from getting in the way of first responders.
- Author Stephen King suffered several broken bones and a collapsed lung in 1999 when he was hit by a driver who claimed he was distracted by his dog.
- In New Jersey, under state law, NJSPCA officers can stop a driver they believe is improperly transporting an animal. Tickets range from \$250 to \$1,000 per offense, and a driver can face a disorderly person's offense under animal-cruelty laws.
- Hawaii explicitly forbids drivers from holding a pet on their lap.
- In Arizona, Connecticut and Maine, distracted-driving laws can be used to charge drivers with pets on their laps.
- In Rhode Island, Democratic state Rep. Peter Palumbo has proposed legislation to make having a dog in your lap a distracted-driving violation after a complaint from someone who witnessed a driver, whose view was blocked by a lap dog, change lanes.
- More states are in the process of adding laws that make it illegal to drive with an unrestrained dog.
