# What you will need:

### Crochet

Red Heart® Super Saver: 8 skeins 311 White A and 2 skeins 319 Cherry Red B.

Crochet Hook: 8mm [US J-10] Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 20 sc = 7'' (18 cm);22 rows= 7" (18 cm); in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

### Knittina

Red Heart® Super Saver: 9 skeins 311 White A and 2 skeins 319 Cherry Red B

Knitting Needles: US 8 [5.0mm] Yarn needle


**GAUGE:** 17 sts = 4'' (10 cm); 31 rows = 4" (10 cm); in garter stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

# Red Heart Cares **Blanket**



Blanket measures approximately 60 x 72" (152.5 x 183 cm) as required by Red Cross

## Crochet

#### Notes

Blanket is made of fifteen 12 x 12" (30 x 31 cm) squares and ten 12 x 16¼" (30 x 41 cm) rectangles.

#### BLANKET

Squares (make 10 with A, make 5 with B)

Ch 35.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn-34 sc. Rows 2-38: Ch 1, sc in each sc.

Fasten off.

# Rectangles (make 10 with A)

Ch 35.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn-34 sc. Rows 2-51: Ch 1, sc in each sc.

Fasten off.

Referring to diagram, sew squares and rectangles together using a whip stitch. Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** A. B = Color A. B; **ch** = chain; **sc** = single crochet; cm = centimeters; yd(s) = yard(s)

# **Knitting**

### Notes

Blanket is made of fifteen 12 x 121/4" (30.5 x 31 cm) squares and ten 12 x 161/2" (30 x 41 cm) rectangles.

PATTERN STITCHES Garter Stitch (any number of sts)

All rows: Knit

#### BLANKET

Squares (make 10 with A, make 5 with B)

Cast on 51 sts. Rows 1-95: Knit.

Bind off.

Rectangles (make 10 with A)

Cast on 51 sts

Rows 1-127: Knit. Bind off.

Referring to diagram, sew squares and rectangles together using a whip stitch. Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** A, B = Color AB:  $\mathbf{k} = \text{knit}$ :  $\mathbf{st(s)} = \text{stitch(es)}$ : cm = centimeters; yd(s) = yard(s)
