"The Parisian Girl: Gerda Wegener and the Power of Her Art"

LOCATION: <u>ARKEN Museum of Modern Art</u>, Ishøj, Denmark.

DATE & TIME: 2:30PM on Tuesday, March 15, 2016, in celebration of the 131st anniversary of Gerda Wegener's birth in Hammelev, Denmark in 1885.

TOPIC: American historian Kent Davis describes how his discovery of an obscure 1913 erotic novel—entirely illustrated by Gerda Wegener—inspired him to create a modern edition of the work.

ARKEN Gerda Wegener Exhibition: On Nov 7, 2015 <u>the ARKEN Museum of Modern Art</u> <u>opened the largest exhibition of Gerda Wegener's art in history</u>. Featuring 178 works, it is her first major showing in Denmark, and one of the first at any museum.

GUEST SPEAKER: Kent Davis is chief editor at <u>DatAsia Press</u>. Working as a literary archaeologist, Davis divides his time between Florida and Southeast Asia.

Marinette, however, is a moral girl—a virgin, no less—and her tale reveals her compelling coming-of-age experiences. She shares her most intimate dreams, hopes, fears and experiences on a journey of self-discovery, filled with humor, drama, romance, heartbreak and, ultimately, epiphany.

In fact, her experiences are *identical* to those young women have today. After more than a century *nothing* has changed!
