mvDVR combines rugged electronics and software designed to provide a cost effective platform for military and first responders to effectively share video amongst team members and leaders.

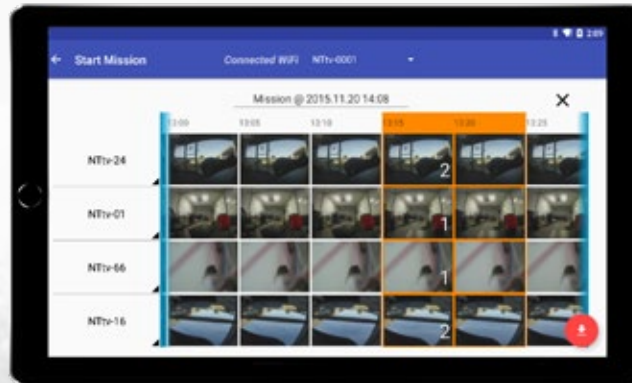

- Record up to 30 hours of video internally, expandable externally

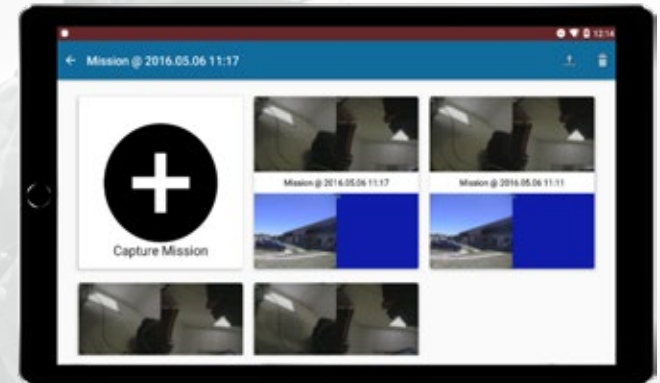
