Buzzy Latin eatery known for creative tapas, tacos & tequila served in low-lit, stylish digs.



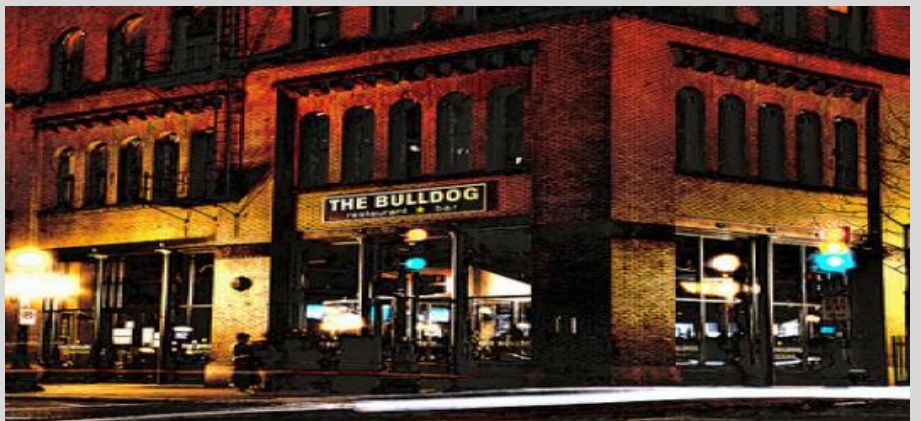
World of Beer
