

To promote and develop the economic potential of the North, the government has set six objectives: i) Encourage the responsible development of natural resources in the North; ii) Leverage the diversity of natural resources, especially in the mining and forestry sectors; iii) Promote private investment; iv) Enhance northern resource processing in Quebec; v) Promote the diversification of regional and local economies, notably by supporting the businesses, regardless of their size or development level; and vi) maximize economic spinoffs for the territory covered by the Plan Nord, and for the province.
