Approximately 100-feet wide, the expansive window and view of the train station, its large-scale public art and view of the Rocky Mountains produces a one-of-a-kind meeting experience.

A convenient midway destination for both business and leisure travelers flying into DEN from the east or west coast, the hotel offers harried travelers a range of world-class amenities and haven for relaxation. Every room in the sleek hotel offers ultimate comfort, innovative technology, and wall-to-wall windows with sweeping views of the Rocky Mountains and Colorado's High Plains.

Guests are provided with refreshing accommodations, such as Westin signature Heavenly® Bed and Heavenly® Bath, featuring the Heavenly® Shower, and can indulge in multiple dining venues that offer a variety of cuisines and nourishing SuperFoodsRx™ menu options. Guests can re-energize in the WestinWORKOUT® Fitness Studio, recharge in the 11th floor indoor swimming pool overlooking the iconic tent roof of the DEN terminal, and unwind in the hot tub while taking in views of the Colorado landscape, airfields, and the Rocky Mountain Front Range.

For guests with a bit more time, the University of Colorado A Line is a 23-mile rail system that transports passengers from the airport to Denver Union Station in the heart of downtown in just 37 minutes. With a \$9 all-day pass, passengers can also connect with the rest of the RTD rail network, along with local and regional buses at the Union Station hub. The rail system makes Denver one of less than 20 airports in the United States with direct rail lines to downtown.
