## BY THE COURT:

Respondent City of Morgan Hill's request for judicial notice in support of its opposition to the petition for writ of supersedeas is granted. Appellant Morgan Hill Hotel Coalition's request for judicial notice in support of its petition for writ of supersedeas is granted.

The petition for writ of supersedeas in the matter of City of Morgan Hill v. Bushey, et al., H043426, is granted as follows: Let the writ of supersedeas issue to stay, pending this appeal, enforcement of the superior court's March 29, 2016 order directing Irma Torrez, City Clerk of the City of Morgan Hill, to certify Morgan Hill Ordinance No. 2131 as duly adopted and effective immediately. This stay shall remain in effect until final determination of the appeal. The Referendum Against Ordinance No. 2131 shall not be placed on any ballot until further order of this court.

The appeal shall be expedited and given calendar preference. Extensions of time for briefing shall not be granted absent an exceptional showing of good cause.
