

THE ORIGINATOR'S SELF-CREATION

36) Does Man think that he Will be left aimless? 37) Was he not a small life-germ in sperm emitted? 38) Then he was a clot; so He Created (him), then made (him) perfect. 39) Then He made of him two kinds, thforme male and the female.

[Holy Quran 75:36-39]

Allah, in the Person of Master Fard Muhammad, taught the Honorable Elijah Muhammad the true knowledge and history of the Creation of the Universe. As such, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad taught that Allah, the Originator of the Universe, is Self-Created; and that HE brought forth the Woman (Female) from HIMSELF, after HIS Self-Creation.

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad further taught that the Originator existed deep in the darkness of space. Therefore, HE Created HIMSELF in this darkness. This naturally and logically makes the First God or Original Man a Black man.

We do not know precisely when HIS Self-Creation occurred nor do we know how long it took HIM to “build up” HIMSELF. HE was the only one present and HE did not record this Event so that we could count time from that specific point. However, we do know that the Originator's Self-Creation occurred beyond 76 trillion years, because the oldest record that we have dates back that far.¹

The Originator, Allah, has no ending. HE is the Eternal. In Sura 2:255, Allah states:

Allah—there is no god but He, the Ever-living, the Self-subsisting by Whom all subsist. Slumber overtakes Him not, nor sleep. To Him belongs whatever is in the heavens and whatever is in the earth. Who is he that can intercede with Him but by His

permission? He knows what is before them and what is behind them. And they encompass nothing of His knowledge except what He pleases. His knowledge extends over the heavens and the earth, and the preservation of them both tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Great.

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Originator is Self-Created from an “Atom of life.” He also called it a “fine” Atom of water. This is affirmed in Sura 25:54:

And He it is Who has created man from water, then He has made for him blood-relationship and marriage-relationship. And thy Lord is ever Powerful.

The Originator tapped into the Power of that fine Atom to manifest HIMSELF in the manner HE desired. The Honorable Elijah Muhammad states:

He was the only One in the whole entire dark Universe. He had to wait until the atom of life produced brains to think what He needed. How long was that? I don't know, Brothers. But He was a Black man! Coming out of total darkness at that time...²

In one respect, the Originator preceded HIS own Self-Creation. This is why the term “Originator” best describes HIM, because it means that which contains its own origin, the essence of itself. The indestructible Atom, itself, contains the Originator’s Essence.

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad continues in describing the Originator’s Self-Creation:

Just think it over; a little small atom of life rolling around in darkness. Think it over; Building itself up, just turning in darkness, making its own self. Let's go into it. Do I have any proof of this? Yes, sir! He made Himself into total darkness. He put His Ownself turning, turning on His Own Timetable in the Black womb of the Universe. He started rotating. He demands every life that comes into the Universe today to start turning first.³

This Self-Creation process is affirmed in Sura 85:13-14:

13) Surely He it is Who creates first and reproduces; 14) And He is the Forgiving, the Loving,

The Originator, in “turning” the first Atom of life, attracted the dark energy in the triple darkness of the Universe to build up HIMSELF. Today, scientists call this substance “dark matter.” They further posit that dark matter can never be created or destroyed, it only changes form.

The Brain was the first organ produced in HIS Self-Creation. The Honorable Elijah Muhammad also states regarding the Originator's creation of the Universe:

In the beginning, the God Who Created Us had no material to use to begin a Creation. He Had only HIMSELF. Therefore out of darkness and the thoughtless and invisible He Brought Out the Visible Vision and Thought and Idea. He Made a Brain, which had the power to cover the sphere of our thinking and to produce from that thought what image or vision that the Brain cells could conceive.⁴

The Brain is the instrument that makes us functional. On this point, Mother Tynetta Muhammad states:

Could it be that thought never dies because it stores the memory of everything in Creation? Is the beginning of thought the beginning of God? These words, “Thought never dies,” comes directly from the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad. He stated that God in his Self-Creation from nothing began from the first brain cell of thought in the dark womb of space.⁵

The Originator's creation of the Universe also establishes the fact that there is life throughout the Universe, and not just on Earth. The many planets, including the Sun, throughout the Universe serve as proof that life exist beyond the Earth. In Sura 42:29, Allah states:

And of His signs is the creation of the heavens and the earth and what He has spread forth in both of them of living beings. And He is All-powerful to gather them together, when He will.

The biology of human life reveals that each life begins as a single cell, produced by the joining of the life-germs—sperm and ovum. This cell “turns” and, as it turns, it multiplies continuously. This ultimately produces cells, numbering into the billions. These cells are organized into tissues and organs to make each human being functional.

The Supreme Wisdom Lessons contain several lessons in which the Honorable Elijah Muhammad answered questions given to Him by Master Fard Muhammad in the early 1930s. These Lessons serve as the basis for the fulfillment of the Biblical and Quranic prophecies.

In Question 37 of Lost-Found Muslim Lesson No. 2 in The Supreme Wisdom Lessons, it states:

Question: Tell us what the Devil teaches the Eighty-Five Percent? That the God is a Righteous and Unseen Being—exists everywhere?

Answer: ALLAH is the God in the Earth and in the Heavens above, and is Just and True, and there is no unrighteousness in HIM. But is not unseen. Is Seen and is Heard everywhere—for HE is the ALL-EYE-SEEING.

The answer gives rise to two essential points. In one respect, Allah, the Originator, is in the very Atom, itself—meaning all Atoms throughout the Universe. Everything that exist in the Universe is made up of Atoms. Everything that has form and function is comprised of Atoms, even the material that is invisible to the naked eye, which includes the Atom, itself.

This is one aspect of how the Originator is the All-Knowing and the ALL-EYE-SEEING. HIS Will is present in everything that exist because everything exists through HIM. In Sura 10:62, it states:

...And not the weight of an atom in the earth or in the heaven is hidden from your Lord, nor anything less than that nor greater...

In Sura 34:22, it states:

Say: Call upon those whom you assert besides Allah; they control not the weight of an atom in the heavens or in the earth, nor have they any partnership in either, nor has He a helper among them.

In Problem 26 of The Problem Book of The Supreme Wisdom Lessons, we are informed of the number of atoms throughout the Universe:

The total Atoms equal 10,000,000,000,000,000,000,00
0,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,00
0,000,000,000,000,000. How many Atoms are there in North America?

The number of Atoms is ten followed by 78 ciphers. The name given to this number is “ten sexvigintillion” (26 sets of 3 zeros).

The question asked by Master Fard Muhammad is, how many of these Atoms are used in North America? What material or objects should we include in answering this question—soil, trees, lakes, humans, etc?

Second, the fact that the Originator created the First Being from HIMSELF is why we cannot separate “God” from “Man”—or why Allah is “Man.” The First God, the Originator, used the Power of Brain to create the entire Universe. HE also established the process through which HE would continue to exist as the Supreme Being through Eternity.

This affirms that no person lives forever because the Earthly material that makes us “persons” undergoes changes that eventually degenerate the human vessel. This is part of the cyclic process of regeneration, which is witnessed in the forming of new life from the regenerated material—meaning that “new” persons are continuously born to replace those who passed away. The Originator is always manifested—through HIS Creation and through the Supreme Being among us.

When people ignorantly suggest or believe that God is a mystery, they are declaring that the Originator of Creation does not exist. They nullify their own existence. This is also a stark manifestation of polytheism, according to Psalm 14:1:

The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, Yakub instructed his “made people,” the Caucasian people, to teach the people that God is a mystery that cannot be seen. He taught them how to challenge the Original People about the origin of the Creator of

the Universe, by asking the question regarding the whereabouts of the First God who created the Universe. At that time, the Original People were put asleep to allow the Caucasian people to rule; and therefore, could not answer this question. They did not know that the First God no longer existed "in Person."

For thousands of years, by propagating the falsehood of a "mystery God" through religion, the Synagogue of Satan has been able to rule over 90 percent of the human population. These false beliefs are behind the self-destruction of the human population. How so? If we knew that each of us manifests the Originator's LIFE, then we would not be eager to destroy our lives and the lives of others.

Notwithstanding the inability of the Original People to answer Yakub's question regarding the whereabouts of the First God, the Originator's Mind and Will permeates the Universe. Therefore, HE does exist in that regard—which is the true Reality of Existence. Let us consider the following from Mother Tynetta Muhammad:

Once I asked the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad if Master Fard Muhammad prays, and he answered, yes. I then asked him to whom does he pray and he responded—to the First God who created the heavens and the earth. This is a true testimony of the power and greatness and honor we pay to the Divine act of Creation in which we would not exist if it were not for the Originator or First God from which we calculate our birth.

This raises another question—Did the first God ever die? The answer then is that the Person of God never dies, but is ever evolving through the law of creation into constant material existence. There is decay in the physical, but there is renewal and continuity.

The Originator established the processes through which HE would always exist "in Person"—through Self-Creation and through the "Woman." In Sura 55:26-27, it states:

26) Everyone on it passes away—27) And there endures for ever the person of thy Lord, the Lord of glory and honour.

THE SECOND SELF OF GOD

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, after the Originator Created HIMSELF, HE brought forth Woman from HIMSELF—as

HIS Second-Self. Let us examine the following from a lecture by Jabril Muhammad:

...GOD Created HIMSELF with needs, but He also Created HIMSELF with the capacity to satisfy HIS own needs. HE desired two things: comfort and company. He desired change—from pain to ease, from discomfort to comfort; and change within HIMSELF. HE also desired to see another “Being” like HIMSELF. HE was confronted with a set of problems, the first of which Originated from HIMSELF. The other set of problems were external to HIMSELF, for beyond HIMSELF was pitch-black—total darkness, nothing; and it was also cold. So, HE went to work to change things, both within HIMSELF and outside of HIMSELF.

This First GOD studied. What did HE study? HIMSELF, it was nothing else for HIM to study. What motivated HIS study? The desire for change for the better.

...This Study was and is the source of all studies. He thoroughly studied HIMSELF in a Supreme effort to satisfy HIS desires, which could only come from the changes, which HE, HIMSELF, determined. HE came to see what was in HIMSELF that could solve both sets of internal problems just mentioned.

Through this process of study, HE generated the image of Woman. HE formed Woman, HIS Second Self, from HIMSELF in HIS imagination. HE conceptualized, designed and determined the structure and Function of Woman. Why? Because SHE is the resolution of HIS problem of discomfort, and SHE was the means by which other Beings could come into Existence. This is the Root of the “pair principle” mentioned throughout the Holy Quran.

HIS study was motivated by the highest kind of Self-Love. SHE was in HIM. HE loved HIMSELF, so HE Created HER out of HIS love for HIMSELF, which was the love of HER as SHE was an essential part of HIMSELF. SHE could not help but love HIM when SHE came forth, for it was from HIS love that HE Created HER. This is the Root of marriage...⁶

Sura 7:189 verifies, in part, the objective to secure “comfort” in bringing forth the woman:

He it is Who created you from a single soul, and of the same did He make his mate, that he might find comfort in her.

This was also the beginning of the Domestic Life. In Sura 4:1, Allah states:

O people, keep your duty to your Lord, Who Created you from a single being and Created its mate of the same (kind), and spread from these two many men and women...

This “single being” is the Originator, the First God or Being, and HE is expressed through the many men and women spread throughout the Earth. This, too, is affirmed in Sura 31:28:

Your creation or your raising is only like a single soul. Surely Allah is Hearing, Seeing.

In the Bible, this is described in Genesis 5:2:

Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

Through the Divine Act of bringing forth the “Woman” from Himself, the Originator established the purpose and function of marriage. This is why it is a Divine Institution. She became the first “Soul Mate.” They established the true definition of the concept of “Soul Mate,” which extends to other beings coming through Her. This makes the concept of “Soul Mate” communal and highly mental and spiritual; and not merely sexual.

Using the language of today, we can say that the Originator is Intelligent, even “Intelligence.” HE knew that HE existed. HE did not want to exist in the condition HE was in—after HIS Self-Creation. Therefore, HE created the forms and capabilities that would enable HIM to function according to HIS own idea of that function. In creating “Brain,” the Originator produced the faculty of “Conscious” or “Consciousness”—to examine HIMSELF and HIS Surroundings. These things are the basis of “Mind.”

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad states, regarding the Originator’s Will:

...God only Wills and there it is. This is the way it began at the beginning.

After God made HIMSELF, He Willed that the heavens that we see above, beneath and around us come to pass. He just Willed

that...His Brain had no limit of power. This power was to be respected and made known.⁷

We live in the Reality of the Originator's Will. This, alone, opens a world of study. One aspect of such a study is the power of imagination. People have written extensively about this subject. Few, if any, have probably gone to the origin of imagination. Why does this mental faculty exist? Merely considering that the Originator existed in triple darkness; yet we behold a marvelous Universe of sound and light, confirms that imagination is a creative force.

The Will, which is borne of Brain, is the force that manifests the ideas generated by the 'Mind' into the Visible Vision. The "Will" is the deliberate action or the determination of the Mind to realize its vision—goals, objectives, aims.

THE UNIQUENESS OF EACH BEING

The Originator's Lifeforce and Will permeate the Universe; therefore, all life exist from HIM. In HIS desire to see other Beings like HIMSELF, HE established processes through which each Being could uniquely express HIS LIFE—so as to not produce a Universe filled with "cookie cutter" Beings. HE did not make HIMSELF a template. HE did not want to "manufacture" other Beings in the manner that companies manufacture tires or brooms.

This is why the process of Creation is not an assembly line, even though the reproduction of life is a constant or fixed process. Uniqueness is intrinsic to anything created.

The Originator determined that each Being would possess the same "Creative Power" used to create the Universe. Why is this? Each Being comes forth to fulfill a specific purpose according to what the Originator has determined for that Being. In Sura 77:20-23, Allah states:

- 20) Did We not create you from ordinary water? 21) Then We placed it in a secure resting-place, 22) Till an appointed term, 23) So We determined—how well are We at determining.

How did the Originator accomplish this goal? First, as previously discussed, HE reproduced HIS Self-Creation through the Woman, HIS Second-Self. In Sura 39:6, Allah states:

...He Creates you in the wombs of your mothers—Creation after Creation—in triple darkness. That is Allah, your Lord; His is the kingdom. There is no God but He...

Second, in this reproductive process of “Creation” through the Woman, each Being or “Person” possesses “Brain,” which enables him/her to explore and seize the vast and unlimited opportunities of “life” in the Universe, through the mental processes of seeing, hearing and feeling, because we interact with our environment through sight, sound and touch. In Sura 16:78, it states:

And Allah brought you forth from the wombs of your mothers—you knew nothing—and He gave you hearing and sight and hearts that you might give thanks.

The process of “giving thanks” is not relegated to mere prayer. It involves living life to its fullest by developing and using our gifts and talents to the greatest extent possible, in service to humanity and ourselves. This is affirmed in Sura 11:7:

And He it is Who created the heavens and the earth in six periods; and His Throne of Power is ever on water that He might manifest (the good qualities in) you, whoever of you is best in deeds...

This also shows that Allah’s Throne of Power is the Brain, which floats on water in the skull or cranium of human beings and other mammals. Why water?

Again, water is at the root of the Origination of Creation. Scientifically, water is the foremost ionic solvent, which means that ionic compounds dissolve easily in water. An ion is a charged atom or molecule. Therefore, the Brain is the instrument through which we manipulate the “matter” of the Universe; thereby, producing infinite forms, shapes and “realities” throughout the Universe. This is an extensive subject.

As indicated in the above verse, we are created to manifest the good qualities and to advance the Originator’s Plan to the best of our ability. The Honorable Elijah Muhammad conveyed aspects of this Plan to us. The first objective is to acquire and accept the true knowledge of God and of ourselves.

The human being’s uniqueness is achieved through the creation of “Mind.” Aspects of “Mind” are acquired through experience in

our environment, from conception through physical death. This is affirmed in Sura 16:78 (above).

Each “Mind” potentially has access to the Originator’s Wisdom, because HIS Mind permeates the Universe—every Atom in the Universe. Each of us possess the potential to draw from this Divine Storehouse of Knowledge, with the permission of the Supreme Being, Master Fard Muhammad. This is affirmed in Sura 2:255:

And they encompass nothing of His knowledge except what He pleases.

However, gaining access to this Wisdom is contingent on the proper development of the mind, which is predicated on submission to HIS Will. In Sura 29:69, Allah states:

And those who strive hard for Us, We shall certainly guide them in Our ways. And Allah is surely with the doers of good.

Acquiring, accepting and studying the true knowledge of Self puts each of us on this necessary course. This is our birthright. We also depend on the Originator and the Supreme Being to guide us in this regard. This is an important point, especially with many people believing that these divine treasures are unconditionally accessible, as if no Supreme Being controls the Universe—both the Seen and the Unseen Realms. In Sura 15:16-18, Allah states:

16) And certainly We have made strongholds in the heaven, and We have made it fair-seeming to the beholders, 17) And We guard it against every accursed devil, 18) But he who steals a hearing; so there follows him a visible flame.

With the thousands of books written about man’s metaphysical abilities, this world is yet divinely-condemned; and those claiming to possess “special powers” have not been able to change their own realities. Many of them believe they are independent of the Universal Change facilitated by the Supreme Being, Master Fard Muhammad. Understanding our relationship to the Originator, the Universe and the Supreme Being is the Root of proper education.

Third, in the reproductive process of Creation through the Woman, the Originator made genetic diversity immutable. This relates to DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid). Genetic traits are both inherited and developed through the journey of life. Other than the physical traits transferred through our genes, each of our life’s experiences are

major contributing factors to the uniqueness of our DNA, which is transferred to our offspring. This is among the reasons why no two “Beings” are exactly alike.

The Brain, which creates aspects of our “individual minds,” combined with the “genetics” that causes physical and mental diversity, produce “Persons” or “human beings” who express the Originator’s Will throughout Eternity. In Sura 64:3, it states:

He created the heavens and the earth with truth, and He shaped you, then made goodly your shapes; and to Him is the resort.

Again, as “Persons,” we are instruments brought forth to achieve the Originator’s Goals and Objectives. This relates to why “Allah,” “I,” “US” and “WE” are used throughout the Holy Quran. Although “us” and “we” are plural, they represent agreement and oneness.

All three points relate to Sura 24:35:

Allah is the light of the heavens and the earth. A likeness of His light is as a pillar on which is a lamp—the lamp is in a glass, the glass is as it were a brightly shining star—lit from a blessed olive-tree, neither eastern nor western, the oil whereof gives light, though fire touch it not—light upon light. Allah guides to His light whom He pleases. And Allah sets forth parables for men, and Allah is Knower of all things—

The “lamp” is the Originator’s LIFE and MIND, while the glass covering the lamp is the created “Person,” who possesses “will” and “mind.” Ideally, each human being is to serve as a “glass” through which the Originator’s Will is to be realized.

The verse also declares that we (glass) are “brightly shining stars lit from a blessed olive-tree, neither eastern nor western, the oil whereof gives light, though fire touch it not—light upon light.” This relates to how life in the Universe is created and sustained. The life we have is sustained by the Energy that produces life. The Atom, itself, generates and regenerates life. Atoms are neither eastern nor western—they are all around us. They permeate the Universe. We acquire this Energy by merely being alive. Through the rays of the Sun, the food we ingest, the air we breathe, and the acquisition and acceptance of truth, our lives are sustained and made purposeful.

“Light upon light” also means Faith in the Reality and Power of Allah. This bears on whether our minds—the “glass”—is crystal clear, blurred or dirty. The state of our minds determine the outcome of our lives.

MINDS OF BELIEF AND DISBELIEF

In Sura 64:1-2, it states:

1) Whatever is in the heavens and whatever is in the earth glorifies Allah. His is the kingdom, and His the praise; and He is Possessor of power over all things. 2) He it is Who created you, but one of you is a disbeliever and one of you is a believer. And Allah is Seer of what you do.

Verse 2 indicates that Allah is aware that people will either believe or disbelieve in Him after they hear the Divine Message of Truth from HIS prophets, messengers and the Messiah. The status of “belief” and “disbelief” only occurs after the truth is made known to us.

Our being shaped by Allah within the womb of our mothers bears heavily on our destinies. Ideally, HE produces the circumstances outside of our mothers’ womb that guide us to the fulfillment of the objectives predetermined for us. Among these circumstances is that HE sends divine messengers from HIMSELF to guide us on the path that leads to HIM. Our designation, as believers or disbelievers, is tied to our response to Allah’s divine intervention. In Sura 37:164, it states:

And there is none of us but has an assigned place...

Categorically, these “assigned places” are described in Sura 56:1-11:

1) When the Event comes to pass— 2) There is no belying its coming to pass— 3) Abasing (some), exalting (others)— 4) When the earth is shaken with a (severe) shaking, 5) And the mountains are crumbled to pieces, 6) So they are as scattered dust, 7) And you are three sorts. 8) So those on the right-hand; how (happy) are those on the right-hand! 9) And those on the left; how (wretched) are those on the left! 10) And the foremost are the foremost— 11) These are drawn nigh (to Allah).

According to the Holy Quran, hypocrites are virulent disbelievers, who once believed. Such persons are counted among the

disbelievers. Ultimately, the intertwining among disbelievers and believers glorifies the Originator. HE advances HIS Plan through HIS creation, which is established on the immutable principle of opposing forces (positive and negative)—hence, the contending of the “believer” with the “disbeliever.”

This process, which gives rise to continuous trials, also transforms some disbelievers into believers, and some believers into hypocrites. In Sura 66:10-11, it states:

10) Allah sets forth an example for those who disbelieve—the wife of Noah and the wife of Lot. They were both under two of Our righteous servants, but they acted treacherously towards them, so they availed them naught against Allah, and it was said: Enter the Fire with those who enter. 11) And Allah sets forth an example for those who believe—the wife of Pharaoh, when she said: My Lord, build for me a house with Thee in the Garden and deliver me from Pharaoh and his work, and deliver me from the iniquitous people.

Through such divinely-ordained opposition, the Originator continuously tests HIS own valor. By persistently overcoming the opposition that HE establishes to oppose HIS Will, the Originator brings about Progress and Perfection.

Patience, forbearance and restraint are required of us, because the Originator’s Plan always comes to fruition. HE is perpetually dealing with HIS own Nature; therefore, HE never gets in the way of achieving HIS Aim and Purpose. HE is not quick to destroy the opposition HE created to advance HIS Will. In Sura 37:1-4, it states:

1) By those ranging in ranks, 2) And those who restrain holding in restraint, 3) And those who recite the Reminder, 4) Surely your God is One.

This indicates that Allah’s Message of Truth, called the Reminder, takes precedence over HIS catastrophic wrath, because Allah’s Aim is to transform the hearts and minds of the people—from ignorance and disbelief into belief. HE brings the Light of Truth to us by degrees; and through the gradual illumination of HIS Light through the evolution of HIS Revelation, darkness is steadily dispelled. This allows many of those who once disbelieved in the Truth to ultimately believe.

PARENTING AND ENVIRONMENT

The fulfillment of the “Person’s” purpose in the Plan of Allah involves “proper” parenting, which incorporates the Science of Mating and the Science of Mothering. These Sciences are also imperative for proper education, and are essential in ensuring that each person has the best opportunity to reach his/her full potential. This, in part, is why the Honorable Elijah Muhammad required that girls begin learning motherhood at 10 years of age. What is motherhood?

Motherhood is the Eternal Domain of Wisdom of the Life-Cycle—that is, from Creation-to-Creation; therefore, it begins with the Originator’s Self-Creation and the reproduction of HIS Self-Creation; and ends with the same, meaning that it never ends. It is Eternal. Our responsibilities are borne of this Life-Cycle because we are facilitators in the creation of other “Beings.”

Mating involves the quintessential effects of the impressions borne of the mother and father’s willful imagination for the destiny of that new Being. The lack or absence of high-quality willful imaginative impressions may compromise the “life’s activity” of that new Being, who is also negatively affected by the careless thinking of its parents. These thoughts and images are impressed on the child to varying degrees.

For example, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad taught that fear was transmitted to the Black People of America through the breast milk of Black women (mothers) during our sojourn as slaves in North America. Black mothers perpetually feared for the safety and survival of their children, especially their male children.

As a result, “fear” became part of the genetic makeup of the Black People of America. This type of fear has been the most potent self-destructive force for Black People.

Each of us is created to fulfill the Originator’s goal for the perpetual improvement of life and Creation. Fear prevents us from achieving the purpose for which we were born.

THE EARTH, HOME OF THE ORIGINATOR

Let us go a bit further. When the Originator Created HIMSELF, where did HE reside? Did HE merely float in space? As previously stated, the Atom that the Originator used to build up HIMSELF in the triple

darkness of space was also used to make everything in the Universe, including the Earth. This is substantiated in the previous excerpt from the Honorable Elijah Muhammad:

...An Atom of Life had to produce flesh, bones and blood from the Earth that He was Self-Created on.⁸

In addition, Sura 2:29 hints to this:

He it is Who created for you all that is in the earth. And He directed Himself to the heaven, so He made them complete seven heavens; and He is Knower of all things.

This does not mean that the Originator floated in space. The phrase, “directed Himself to the heaven” means that HE created the Universe. HE occupied the triple darkness. HE was the Light in the triple darkness—a part of it, which ultimately manifested as HIS Universe.

The Originator made the Earth HIS Home. This, in many respects, places the Earth at the Center of the Universe. It is not the Center of the Planetary System, because it revolves around the Sun. However, everything in the Universe revolves around the Originator, who is the true Center of the Universe. HE “willed” everything into existence; and HIS Will upholds everything in the Universe. In Sura 2:255, Allah states, in part:

...His knowledge extends over the heavens and the earth, and the preservation of them both tires Him not. And He is the Most High, the Great.

Also in Sura 13:2, it states, in part:

Allah is He Who raised the heavens without any pillars that you can see, and He is established on the Throne of Power...

Today, some scientists are declaring that the Earth is the center of the Universe, instead of the Sun. They believe that what they thought they knew about the Universe is, in fact, lacking much in knowledge and truth.⁹ They now see Earth as a very unique and special place in the Universe.

Modern science is saturated with guesses, lies, inordinate self-interest, and arrogance. Some of these scientists further lament that

they have been taught and influenced to convey misinformation about the Universe to the public—by not challenging antiquated theories.

In Question 9 of Lost-Found Muslim Lesson No. 1 in The Supreme Wisdom Lessons, it states, in part:

...The Universe is everything—Sun, Moon and Stars. They are planets. Planets are something grown or made from the beginning.

This lends to the previous statement that the Earth was formed from Atoms. Here, we must note that Master Fard Muhammad defined “planet.” As indicated, HE classified the stars as planets, too.

Furthermore, in Lost-Found Muslim Lesson No. 2 of The Supreme Wisdom Lessons, we are informed that the Earth is the home of Islam. This is affirmed in Sura 21:30:

Do not those who disbelieve see that the heavens and the earth were closed up, so We rent them. And We made from water everything living. Will they not then believe?

“Rent,” in this context, refers to opening or unraveling something by tearing, slitting or splitting it. Synonyms for “rent” include cleft, divide, or separate. “Rent” does not imply a violent and chaotic destructive process. This relates to how the Originator created the Universe. According to Maulana Muhammad Ali’s commentary of Sura 35:1, the Arabic word for originate is “Fatir.”

God is here mentioned by his name Fatir, from fatara, which means he clove or split, also he originated or brought a thing into existence newly or for the first time, it not having existed before. There may be reference to the creation of primeval matter in the original significance of cleaving or splitting.

As it relates to this, Mother Tynetta Muhammad states:

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad takes us back to the atom of life itself and explains that everything inside the atom, when cracked, brings forth everything that was contained inside.¹⁰

In the creation of the Universe, the “Atom” was rent asunder. The proper concept of the creative process of “renting asunder,” includes “deconstruction” and “construction.” Both processes denote “order” and “organization,” not chaos. The first law of Creation is motion, and the second law is order.

Motion is measured in its action and timing. In Sura 13:8, it states, in part:

Allah knows what every female bears, and that of which the wombs fall short of completion and that which they grow. And everything with Him has a measure.

Our bodies are sustained by biological processes that build up and breakdown the tissues of our bodies—anabolism and catabolism, respectively; also known as metabolism. In essence, atoms are rented, assembled and disassembled, continuously, throughout life in the Universe. The scientific terms for these processes are fusion and fission.

Consequently, this divine knowledge from the Honorable Elijah Muhammad shows the Big Bang and Chaos theories as insufficient in explaining the origin and creation of the Universe. Both theories have evolved since their initial publishing. The following is an overview of the Big Bang theory:

The Big Bang theory is an effort to explain what happened at the very beginning of our universe. Discoveries in astronomy and physics have shown beyond a reasonable doubt that our universe did in fact have a beginning. Prior to that moment there was nothing; during and after that moment there was something: our universe. The big bang theory is an effort to explain what happened during and after that moment.

According to the standard theory, our universe sprang into existence as a “singularity” around 13.7 billion years ago. What is a “singularity” and where does it come from? Well, to be honest, we don’t know for sure. Singularities are zones which defy our current understanding of physics. They are thought to exist at the core of “black holes.”

Black holes are areas of intense gravitational pressure. The pressure is thought to be so intense that finite matter is actually squished into infinite density (a mathematical concept which truly

boggles the mind). These zones of infinite density are called “singularities.” Our universe is thought to have begun as an infinitesimally small, infinitely hot, infinitely dense, something—a singularity. Where did it come from? We don’t know. Why did it appear? We don’t know.¹¹

This world’s scientists have yet to answer the two questions (above). What then is the quality of their knowledge if these foundational questions have not been answered? How can you effectively learn and teach something if you do not know its origin and its purpose? This is why most of what this world’s scientists teach about the Universe is speculation based on theories and conjecture. Yet, they position these guesses as facts and knowledge, and then pass it on to others through their school systems.

The scientists of this world have neither acknowledged nor accepted the Wisdom of Master Fard Muhammad expressed through the Teachings of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, who taught us the origin and root of everything that exists. HE has the invincible truth.

Again, according to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Universe is approximately 78 trillion years old, and not 13.7 billion years as hypothesized by scientists of this world. In addition, the Universe has its origin in the Originator’s “Will” and “Thought”—therefore, to examine the Universe absent the knowledge about and of the Originator leads to a dead end. Scientists are now acknowledging this dead end.

A comprehensive study of the Original Man, who is the God of the Universe, is at the foundation of understanding the Universe. This makes hatred of the Original People a stumbling block for Caucasian scientists, in particular. How can a person hate the people whose “Mind” created the Universe, while attempting to gain detailed knowledge about the Universe? This is senseless in every respect.

The “Chaos Theory” seeks to recognize and classify natural phenomena that is unpredictable, and as such, have an appearance of disorder or instability but may operate according to higher laws of organization. “Chaos” is not the best term to use when one’s quest

is to understand the Universe. However, it may be the correct word to describe this world's scientists' inability to grasp the magnificence of the Universe. In Sura 67:3-4, Allah states:

3) ...Thou seest no incongruity in the creation of the Beneficent. Then look again: Canst thou see any disorder? 4) Then turn the eye again and again — thy look will return to thee confused, while it is fatigued.

Taking the concept of "chaos" on face-value, we know that nothing in the Universe is chaotic. The Sun, Moon and Stars are Planets that were grown. Therefore, they did not begin as we view them, today. They began as we do—something microscopically small, then built up through time.

Growth is a demonstration of order, to varying degrees, because it can be measured, calculated and controlled—by those having power to control it. On this point, our inability to control a process does not mean that the process cannot be controlled. It is arrogant to think this way. The medical scientists of this world are not the inventors of the evolutionary processes of maturation and perfection; the Originator is.

Again, Allah measures everything that exists in HIS Universe and HE presides over its growth and maintenance. This is associated with HIS attribute "Rabb," which means "to nurture something from its beginning through its development, stage-by-stage, until it is complete and reaches its perfection. Completion is the apex of development, while perfection is the quality of that completion. In Sura 87:1-3, Allah states:

1) Glorify the name of thy Lord, the Most High! 2) Who creates, then makes complete, 3) And Who measures, then guides...

For example, although we plant the seed, only Allah causes it to grow because, as the Creator of the seed, HE knows its "measurement." In Sura 56:63-64, Allah states:

63) See you what you sow? 64) Is it you that cause it to grow, or are We the Causer of growth?...

The biological initiation and development of human life serve as evidence of the Self-Creation of the First God, the Earth and the Universe. How so? In Sura 23:12-14, Allah states:

12) And certainly We create man of an extract of clay, 13) Then We make him a small life-germ in a firm resting-place, 14) Then We make the life-germ a clot, then We make the clot a lump of flesh, then We make (in) the lump of flesh bones, then We clothe the bones with flesh, then We cause it to grow into another creation. So blessed be Allah, the Best of creators!

If we place this atop of the process of human fertilization, the “firm resting” place could be considered the placenta, which is in the womb. The placenta is an organ formed at the outset of pregnancy that connects the developing fetus to the uterine wall. Functionally, it enables the new life to receive nutrients and other substances essential for its development. Therefore, the placenta functions like the Earth and the woman’s womb is similar to the triple darkness of space.

Currently, biological researchers suggest that the placenta forms during the fourth week of pregnancy, along with the heart, kidneys, liver, intestines and nervous system. On the contrary, the forming of this organ (along with other organs) occurs long before it is detected by imaging equipment manufactured by this world’s scientists. These organs begin to form at conception. The truth of Creation is unfathomably deeper and richer than machines could ever reveal.

After the Earth was fully formed to support “human” life, the Original People descended to occupy it. Regarding this, Mother Tynetta Muhammad states:

The Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad also taught us that the original arc or spot of the heavens from which we originated and made our descent was located above the site that we call the Kabah today at the Holy City of Mecca in Arabia. In Islamic terminology, this original arc or spot would represent the heavenly Kabah to which the present cubicle house of the Kabah is aligned.

This knowledge may also explain the origin of the Sacred Black meteorite Stone that is located in the Northeast corner of the

Kabah, which represents our original Black ancestors symbolizing their descent to our Planet Earth.¹²

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Holy City Mecca is the Root of the Original People's Civilization on Earth.

What do we mean by "descent to our Planet Earth"? The Original People could not manifest in this "human" form until the Earth was ready to receive us, because the human vessel is made of the Earth. This is substantiated in Problem 12 of The Problem Book in The Supreme Wisdom Lessons—in which we are taught that the square mileage of the State of Michigan is 57,980, and it has a population of 4,842,200 people. We are also informed that one cubic foot of common Earth weighs 80 pounds. It further states in this Problem:

...One common Ca. weighs one hundred and seventy pounds. The average original weighs one hundred fifty pounds and there are five hundred thousand original nations living in the State of Michigan; approximately eight million livestock of all kinds. The average one weighs six hundred pounds, and the construction of human all other than the level surface of the Earth is approximately one hundred fifty billion tons...

The phrase "construction of human all other than the level surface of the Earth" indicates that the Earth is Human. "Hum" means earth or ground. The life on Earth is constructed from the material of the Earth. Again, this material is made of Atoms. In Sura 71:17-18, Allah states:

- 17) And Allah has caused you to grow out of the earth as a growth,
- 18) Then He returns you to it, then will He bring you forth a (new) bringing forth.

This "you" is the "human being," in general. This "you" is also each unique expression of the Originator's LIFE, which we call our "individual" lives. However, we are more "unique," and less "individual" because we are all connected since the Originator is One. This is the best way to understand our place in the Universe. "Uniqueness" includes our personal experiences and contribution to Allah's Creation.

In fact, this point cannot be emphasized enough because the false concept that we are independently detached from each other is at the root of this evil world. False concepts have produced gross selfishness that has given rise to injustice throughout the Earth. This has made each of us the perpetrator and victim of wickedness.

Problem 12 also reveals that we are “divine beings” in human form. However, the rulers of this wicked world have influenced us to see ourselves as merely human beings, with spirituality as an option.

What form did we, the Original People, have before inhabiting the Earth? Regarding this, Mother Tynetta Muhammad states:

My son, Rasul Muhammad, once asked Sister Bernsteen Muhammad, who served as secretary to Master Fard Muhammad in the early 1930’s: How did God communicate in space before settling on this planet? She stated that according to the Master, God traveled and communicated in an “orb.”

This term, “orb” has recently been discovered, as Being a circular-like, transparent object photographed in our atmosphere containing Consciousness that we may not be able to detect. Thus, it appears that our human anatomy or structure, as we know it, evolved from a form of an invisible presence or “orb” occupying space with a membrane of intelligence and Brain cells that ultimately Manifests in a physical form.¹³

Invisible, in this case, means that “orbs” are not readily visible to the naked eye. The high frequency and vibratory state of orbs make them difficult for us to detect.

Sura 71:14 affirms that the form of the Original Man went through various stages of development during this 78 trillion-year period, which is also witnessed in the development of the human body:

14) And indeed He has created you by various stages.

The “stages” represent the evolutionary development of the Original Man. This is the process of “making complete” mentioned in Sura 87:2. In Sura 32:9, Allah states:

Then He made him complete and breathed into him of His spirit, and gave you ears and eyes and hearts; little it is that you give thanks!

Why is this knowledge of Allah (God) important? This Reality sets us on the course to gain a pristine understanding of the Originator and HIS Second-Self, the Woman. How so? Neither Man nor Woman was in the anatomical form that we see today. This evil world parades nudity throughout the mass media to incite lust, and to devalue the most important aspects of the human being—intelligence and spirituality.

The nature of the Conscious or Mind, in part, distinguishes the Male from the Female. True male and female relationships are established from Mind-to-Mind and Heart-to-Heart, as both involve the Electromagnetic Energy and consciousness that generate and sustain Life. This knowledge moves us beyond the warped concepts of “Male” and “Female” given to us by the scholars of this divinely-condemned world.

Among the realities that also stand out in the excerpt by Jabril Muhammad previously presented, is the extraordinary value of the Woman. The Originator brought Her forth from HIMSELF as the solution to problems that involved how HE desired to exist and function. Among these, was HIS desire for comfort.

Therefore, the Woman is not brought forth for sport and play. “Comfort” does not denote folly and frolicking; nor does it suggest that She is a slave to the whims and whiles of men. Comfort includes actions that soothe, console, and reassure.

As the “Second-Self” of the Originator, the Woman is also incomprehensible, meaning that Her value is limitless and infinite. When understanding this, we are forced to confront the dire need to rid ourselves of the false concepts, notions, and so-called knowledge about women ingrained in us by the satanic leaders whose world of evil we have lived directly under for more than a thousand years.

The satanic world leaders of the Synagogue of Satan have made women commodities and merchandise; and when we adopt this false concept, we become “players” in the inhumane commercialization of women, to the detriment of our lives and humanity. Discarding these corrupt and injurious concepts about women and

life, in general, may take generations. This is how entrenched this evil has been indoctrinated into the human psyche and genome.

LESSONS IN THE SELF-CREATION

As we examine the Originator's Self-Creation, we gain awareness of our innate competitive nature. HE competed within HIMSELF by going to war with the darkness and coldness of space. HE made darkness an opponent, because HE desired to overcome and master it. HE could not act friendly towards something HE wanted to defeat and control. HE would not have achieved HIS goal if HE did. HE did not make darkness an enemy, only an opponent. There is a difference.

Competition is borne of the desire to achieve an objective, and it starts within one's self. This innate competitive nature is indicated in Sura 2:148:

And everyone has a goal to which he turns (himself), so vie with one another in good works...

“Vie” is synonymous with compete. Unbeknown to many of us, we are always competing for something. At the very core, each of us compete against ourselves to varying degrees. Ideally, each of us is always striving to overcome some fault, impediment or habit that prevents us from improving our lives. Each of us must overcome doubt, fear, the lack of confidence and belief in one's self to achieve the most worthy goals. These attitudes or dispositions are opponents. They are actually our real enemies. The spirit of competition drives our pursuit of happiness, which is achieved through self-discovery and the accomplishments borne of it.

The Originator's Self-Creation also shows us that the solutions to our problems are within “self.” The fact that the Originator brought forth, from HIMSELF, the solutions to solve HIS greatest problems, means that inherent in our nature is the capacity to solve our problems. This includes the natural inclination to rely on Allah, the Source of our lives.

In our case, however, this “self” also encompasses other human beings. The fact that the Originator brought forth another “Being” from HIMSELF to resolve a set of problems, tells us that some solutions to our problems are found in other people. We are dependent on Allah, but interdependent on each other. No man or woman is

an island. We are social Beings who must work together to improve ourselves and our surroundings.

We also learn through the Originator's Self-Creation that the prerequisites for success in solving problems are "self-love" and "the study of self." Without self-love, a person cannot plumb the depths of his or her "being" to discover the innate potential that ultimately leads to success in overcoming the many challenges that accompany "life" as we know it. Therefore, being robbed of self-love and made to hate one's self are among the most formidable detriments to one's survival and success in life.

Other detriments to success include the lack of knowledge of self and of Allah. The absence of such requisite knowledge is destructive to our lives. These scourges prevent us from living the life the Originator predestined for each of us.

This satanic world deceives us into searching for solutions outside of ourselves. We have embraced this false concept because it seems to be the easier road—as the study of self can be arduous. Self-discovery requires patience, courage, knowledge, wisdom; and a clear identification of the need(s) that must be met or fulfilled. This involves mental work. We have to face truths about ourselves that we sometimes choose not to confront. Eliminating personal faults and counterproductive habits are prerequisites for solving some of the problems we encounter.

When we identify a problem, we inherently know that we have a goal or an objective that must be met to solve that problem. This places the problem within the context of a scientific process to resolve it. This problem remains until it is resolved. Once we find the solution, the problem can be solved (the need fulfilled or situation improved). Sometimes this is not as simple as it sounds because subsequent problems may arise when we resolve the initial problem. This is usually the case for complex situations involving families, communities and civilizations.

Notwithstanding, problems can only be resolved by solutions. The journey in life is inundated with challenges in the form of problems within self and outside of self. We must overcome these problems to reach the goals that make our lives worth living. The ultimate goal is oneness with Allah, which is affirmed in Sura 84:6:

O man, thou must strive a hard striving (to attain) to thy Lord,
until thou meet Him.

Oneness with Allah is achieve through obedience to HIS Will. This requires our having to understand the value of freedom, justice and equality in our interactions with each other. We have to treat "Creation" as Allah does.

What was the extent of the "comfort" that the Originator desired in bringing forth Woman from HIMSELF? What was the Originator's idea of companionship (company)? Did this companionship extend into a Partnership in Creating and Sustaining the Universe? Did She have a role in producing this marvelous Universe? A superficial observation into the nature of the Woman reveals that She is the Co-Creator of the Universe. However, since She is from the Originator, the Reality is not "Co-," but simply Creator.

When considering why and how the Originator brought forth the Woman as HIS Second-Self, we also gain an understanding of our nature, specifically the natural attraction between Man and Woman. This innate attraction is deeply rooted in the Originator's Self-Creation, which is also Her Creation. In Sura 30:21, Allah states:

And of His signs is this, that He Created mates for you from yourselves that you might find quiet of mind in them, and He put between you love and compassion...

She endeared in the Originator the awesome desire to secure, protect and honor Her and to love Her; while Her essential desire was/ is to make life easier for HIM; to reproduce (re-create) HIM perpetually; and to manifest HIS Ideas. Together, THEY were (are) the match created in Heaven, which produced Heaven throughout the Universe.

By possessing the Wisdom of the Originator's Self-Creation, we prevent ourselves from being exploited by the satanic leaders of this divinely-condemned world, who contrive circumstances and social systems that corrupt and misdirect the natural inclination that men have for women and vice versa. Subsisting under the burden of their false and hateful concepts about life has made us purveyors of the grief and anguish that afflict us. Their diabolical aim is to turn men and women against each other, which is directly opposite the natural order of life. This satanic objective is consistent with this unnatural world.

PERFECTION THROUGH THE ORIGINATOR'S DOMESTIC LIFE

In Sura 4:1, Allah states:

O people, keep your duty to your Lord, Who created you from a single being and created its mate of the same (kind), and spread from these two many men and women.

This affirms that every person is of the Originator's Domestic Life. This is the only Domestic Life that exists. This is what makes us a "human family." This is also what makes us "one" with everything else in Creation.

In Sura 30:21, previously cited, Allah confirms that the love between the Originator and HIS Second-Self is innate in each of us. This is at the root of our nature, and this is what makes marriage a divine institution, as previously stated.

As it relates to the "pair principle," let us consider the meaning of pair—two identical, similar, or corresponding things that are matched for use together; or something consisting of or regarded as having two parts or pieces joined together. The "pair principle" is described throughout the Holy Quran. The following verses mention "pairs":

Sura 35:11

And, Allah Created you from dust, then from the life-germ, then He made you pairs. And no female bears, nor brings forth, except with His knowledge.

Sura 36:36

Glory be to Him Who Created pairs of all things, of what the Earth grows, and of their kind and of what they know not!

Sura 42:11

The Originator of the heavens and the Earth. He has made for you pairs from among yourselves...

Sura 53:45-46

45) And that He Creates pairs, the male and the female: 46)
From the small life-germ when it is adapted:

Do men and women perceive themselves as pairs or as disjointed opposites? This question is not confined to how we view marriage, but extends to our overall perception of the opposite gender.

The egregious abuse of women throughout the Earth shows that humanity is ignorant of the Origin of Creation, which is the origin of both Man and Woman. Realizing that there is a divine destiny that we must fulfill, in partnership with our mates, fosters a much higher level of maturity than what is currently being demonstrated in this world. This, alone, affirms the dire need to build strong and functional families based on Allah's Plan for the Perfection of Life and the Universe. The Honorable Elijah Muhammad introduced to aspects of this Plan.

Today, more than seven billion people live on the Earth, and each one came through the only process available, which is the Originator's Creative Process. This means that, as a human family, we are endowed with the potential to, collectively, satisfy our needs. No human being should be living without the necessities required to make his/her life worth living—that is, freedom, justice, equality, the resources to sustain life, and the unfettered pursuit of happiness. Allah requires us to embrace the wisdom that guarantees the attainment of these necessities.

The fruit of this wisdom cannot be fully realized until the Synagogue of Satan and its evil world are completely destroyed. This has been underway since 1914—when this current civilization expired. The introduction of Allah's Divine Wisdom through the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and the Honorable Louis Farrakhan is bringing about the transition of worlds—from Satan's world to the Eternal Kingdom of Allah.

Embracing the Teachings of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad gives us purpose within Allah's Plan. In Sura 75:36-39, Allah states:

36) Does Man think that he Will be left aimless? 37) Was he not a small life-germ in sperm emitted? 38) Then he was a clot; so He Created (him), then made (him) perfect. 39) Then He made of him two kinds, the Male and the Female.

These verses are ideal for helping us understand the Domestic Life of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and the Honorable Louis Farrakhan from the point of that "Single Being"—WHO did not Create HIMSELF aimlessly, but WHO has Aims; and WHO Functions according to the requirements to achieve those Aims.

What is an aim? An aim is an objective or goal, but it involves the act of directing one's energy or resources toward a particular target.

The Originator's aims arose from the essential question: How do I want to exist? HIS Self-Creation was the first answer to this question. HE manifested HIMSELF through Brain and Thought in the triple darkness of space. HE remained in the process of self-discovery after HIS Self-Creation. The study of one's self is the process of self-discovery, which leads to the unveiling of one's potential, purpose and destiny.

Identifying areas that can be improved is intrinsic in the developmental process of everything. This is a perpetual process. Even though the Originator Created HIMSELF meticulously and perfectly according to Sura 75:38, this did not eliminate the reality that HE could only effectively study aspects of HIMSELF after HIS Self-Creation. HIS desire to improve HIS condition, internally and externally, prompted this Study.

This is why, according to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Original Man is always experimenting to improve and perfect life. Innately, we are never satisfied with the "status quo." The Honorable Elijah Muhammad warns us against becoming complacent and settling for mediocrity, because this attitude destroys the competitive nature of life, which is that underlining drive to discover new adventures and challenges.

The Originator did not want to exist in loneliness, darkness and cold after HE Created HIMSELF. HE also did not want to continue to endure the pain experienced in HIS own Self-Creation. HE aimed to improve the process of reproducing HIS Self-Creation, as previously stated.

These realities relate to Sura 75:39. This is where aspects of the imperfection of the Original Man rests—in the reproduction of Creation, as described in Sura 39:6. This problem was in the genetics of the Original Man.

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the "brown" germ in the genetic material of the Original Man was the problem that needed to be solved in order to realize perfection on this Earthly Plane. The brown germ was isolated and fully manifested by Yakub

in the form of the Caucasian people and their horrific rule over the Original People.

The depletion of the brown germ to its final stage of white is the process of taking something down to its “bare bones.” Problems and their causes are identified during the process. Only Allah knows the full scope of how this brown germ was analyzed.

Consequently, the greatest accomplishment realized in the Original Man’s history is the Perfection of the Original Man as Manifested in the Person of Master Fard Muhammad, the Supreme Being. As a result, Allah states in Sura 5:3:

... This day have I perfected for you your religion and completed My favour to you and chosen for you Islam as a religion...

This indicates that the Teachings of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad is the “favor,” and represents the true religion of Islam, because its ever-evolving expression ultimately brings about perfection. We have never known Islam until this point in time.

Let each of us now place ourselves in the Originator’s shoes—not as HIM, per se; but as a person born to pursue perfection. As such, we have the innate responsibility to improve ourselves, advancing stage-after-stage. Again, the desire to strive for perfection is inherent in our nature. In Sura 22:5, Allah states:

O people, if you are in doubt about the Resurrection, then surely We Created you from dust, then from a small life-germ, then from a clot, then from a lump of flesh, complete in make and incomplete, that We may make clear to you...

What is meant by incomplete? It is the absence of perfection. That which is “incomplete” includes not yet knowing or understanding one’s purpose for having been born. Mother Tynetta Muhammad states:

The Black man’s origin is of star material or cosmic dust. Each time we descend to earth and are born in the womb of our mothers, we carry with us in our deep-seated consciousness, an aspect of our star histories inherited from the gods since the beginning of time.¹⁴

Our connection to the origin of Creation is innate. Coming forth from our mothers' wombs puts us on the course to reconnecting to our true selves in the Oneness of Allah. This is a lifelong journey. Our progress along this line determines the quality of our existence.

Among the most penetrating questions that can drive one's self-discovery is the same question that the Originator asked HIMSELF: How do I want to exist?

Before going further into this subject, it is necessary for us to be mindful of "where we are at this point in time," regarding: 1) the world in which we currently live; 2) the credit it deserves; and 3) where that credit should be placed. This gives us the opportunity to humble ourselves; thereby, enabling us to consider new wisdom when it comes our way, even if this wisdom is contrary to what we have been taught. Our perpetual duty, as divine beings, is to accept the truth when we learn of it.

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, this current world was predetermined to express unimaginable evil, the likes of which has never existed in the 76-plus trillion years of the Original People's history. This world of evil is the fulfillment of the prophecy of Sura 2:30:

And when thy Lord said to the angels, I am going to place a ruler in the earth, they said: Wilt Thou place in it such as make mischief in it and shed blood? And we celebrate Thy praise and extol Thy holiness. He said: Surely I know what you know not.

The unleashing of worldwide mischief and bloodshed by the Caucasian people was necessary in the process of the Perfection of the Original Man. This means that this world gets credit for serving as the furnace of affliction required to "burn off" the impediments in the Original Man's nature, in helping to produce the greatest people that ever lived, the Black People of the Western Hemisphere. This is affirmed in Isaiah 48:10:

Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction.

Having to subsist under this satanic governance caused incomprehensible pain, and ultimately manifested the fulfillment of the Originator's Goal to perfect the Original Man. The achievement of

this Goal is manifested in the Person of Master Fard Muhammad, humanity's Saviour and the Re-Creator of the Universe.

This "Hell" could not be realized unless the rulers of it were denied access to the Supreme Wisdom of Allah. Actually, their accessing such wisdom would have caused more hell. This is why Allah buried and destroyed the advanced civilizations of the Original People before Yakub made the Caucasian people 6,000 years ago.

The Caucasian people had to build a world according to their weak nature and the meager knowledge that Moses, their prophet, brought them. As a result, the satanic leaders of this evil world function extremely below the innate potential of the life of the Original Man. Considering the horrific state of this world, only the most ignorant people will doubt this fact.

This world, consequently, gets very little credit for its so-called "wisdom" about life and the Universe. The unspeakable evil, which is now "speakable," committed every moment of the day on Earth is proof that the wisdom of this world is deadly when followed. We should not deceive ourselves into believing that we possess a root understanding of anything just because we matriculated through the educational institutions of this divinely-condemned world. In First Corinthians 3:19, we learn what this so-called knowledge means to Allah:

For the Wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

In Sura 67:5, Allah states that HE makes the lower heavens a means of conjecture for the devils—that is, those who deny the existence of Allah, while attempting to expound on HIS Creation, as if they were present when HE Created the Heavens and the Earth.

One reason why the wisdom of this world is foolishness to Allah is because the nature of those who rule this world is inclined to divisiveness. They are adamant about producing divisions among people by causing dissension, discord and disagreement.

Because the grafting process through which the Caucasian race was made involved "separating," "dividing," and "distinguishing" one human being from another, this is how the Caucasian race perceives and treats everything. Social, political, religious, and

economic apparatuses are established on the basis of discrimination. Why is this?

Racism, classism, and chauvinism (gender) are inherent in the Caucasian people's genetic makeup and psyche. They aggressively search for points of division, and then judge the worthiness of each point or part as it relates to other parts, as well as the whole, while never acknowledging the existence of the whole. This is bizarre in many respects, and reveals the insanity in such thinking.

This unnatural tendency is the basis of discriminatory injustice that most people accept and express, despite being willing victims of it. This is at the core of the Caucasian people's thinking and decision-making. This prevents them from empathizing with those whom they have deemed different and subordinate to them. The manifestation of this insanity is relative to the "class" of Caucasian people in question. The ruling families of the Caucasian people have no empathy for anyone, including their own poor people. On the other hand, poor Caucasian people manifest hatred toward other races.

Knowing that such a demented psyche has divided and destroyed millions of lives should make us increasingly conscientious of its presence in our own minds. However, most people are oblivious to the root of their self-destructive thoughts arising from concepts and perceptions that are notoriously divisive.

This satanic way of thinking is in direct opposition to the nature of life, which is "Oneness" as stated in Sura 112:

- 1) Say: He, Allah, is One. 2) Allah is He on Whom all depend. 3) He begets not, nor is He begotten; 4) And none is like Him.

The Root of this "Oneness" or "Divine Unity" is exquisitely characterized in Sura 75:39:

Then He made of him two kinds, the male and the female.

The fact that men and women come "together" to produce children (life) erases any notion that the natures of the two are opposites or that they are natural rivals. Through the institution of marriage, other predestined objectives are achieved based on harmony between the two.

Producing and caring for our families represent the rudimentary level of our functions. Yet, there is a global struggle to uphold these

basic responsibilities, to the point where Allah reminds us of this. In Sura 4:1, Allah states, in part:

...And keep your duty to Allah, by Whom you demand one of another (your rights), and (to) the ties of relationship. Surely Allah is ever a Watcher over you.

The high divorce rate, the vast number of children born out of wedlock; and the complete abandonment of women and children throughout the world serve as proof that we have not kept our duty to Allah nor have we honored "ties of relationship." This is due to the satanic socioeconomic systems that hinder most people from adequately fulfilling their responsibilities. The Messiah's work involves correcting these scourges throughout the Earth.

To reiterate, our understanding of the Originator's Self-Creation, Creation and the principles that undergird "life" in the Universe are essential to the proper development of our God-potential; and the realization of strong, even, perfect families.

THE ORIGINATOR'S DOMESTIC LIFE

6) Such is the Knower of the unseen and the seen, the Mighty, the Merciful, 7) Who made beautiful everything that He created, and He began the creation of man from dust. 8) Then He made his progeny of an extract, of worthless water. 9) Then He made him complete and breathed into him of His spirit, and gave you ears and eyes and hearts; little it is that you give thanks!
 [Holy Quran 32:6-9]

Allah requires some of HIS servants to accept higher levels of duty that are divinely-consequential because they were predestined to perform these functions. Such functions are intimately attached to and aligned with Allah's Plan for the Perfection of Creation. This also entails the advancement of humanity into a perfected state.

The duties of these Special Servants involve aspects of divine rulership and governance of the Earth and the Heavens, and of all "Life" therein. The 24 Holy Wise Scientists (the Writers of the Original People's History) and Their Wives are among this special group of Divine Servants.

What universal and global circumstances give rise to such Persons? The Originator's Self-Creative Process birthed Laws into the Universe. These Laws are borne of the Originator's Mind and Will. Among these Laws is that whenever the need for humanity to solve a problem of enormous magnitude is great, such as the yearning for justice and peace in a world ravaged by injustice and violence, the Universe responds to the deafening outcry of the people for relief. In time, women will give birth to those predestined to resolve these monumental problems.

Because these persons are born to achieve such lofty objectives, they are innately furnished with predetermined ideas that drive

them to complete their work. And, because the Originator called them into existence through this immutable Universal Law, the Power of the Universe supports them. Any opposition against them is futile—particularly, once they accept and understand their purpose for living and the duties associated with it. Regarding this Universal Law, several vital questions are:

- What qualities must such persons possess?
- What conditions must be present to ensure that such persons are successful?

The Originator's resolutions to the problems HE faced before, during and after HIS Self-Creation were not temporary and fleeting. HIS thorough study of HIMSELF to improve HIS condition ensured that the solutions arising from HIS self-study achieved those outcomes. HE eliminated the problems that made HIS condition undesirable. This did not mean that HIS solutions did not produce challenges. They did. This is usually the reality because challenges are intrinsic to the process of perfection.

Therefore, in solving problems consequential to the Originator's Goal of Perfection, HE not only governs the birth, and the spiritual and intellectual development of those persons predestined to complete this specific work, but HE also produces the circumstances that bring those persons together when the time arrives for them to begin their work.

The "gathering" of these persons at such time is similar to the process of how HE "built up" Himself during HIS Self-Creation—atom by atom—to create the "functional" vessel to express HIS Will. Likewise, these persons are like atoms, harnessed as a single "function" to express the Originator's Will. Again, this is why they were created.

Whether there are five, 10, 20, 100, or 1,000 persons ultimately unified to complete that specific work, Allah views them as one—as it relates to their preordained assignments and their success through their collective effort and labor. Each person's willingness to acknowledge, accept, and submit to this reality bears on his/her ability to fulfill his/her predestined role in this function. Any deficit in this area potentially jeopardizes the achievement of their individual roles and assignments within their collective function.

A team sport is a prime example of this, especially when analyzing the attitudes that prevail in championship teams. All members usually share the same determination and are in harmony. Each member takes full responsibility for his/her part in ensuring the team's success. This is what makes a team "We," instead of 'I.' The sentiment borne of a true "We" is not, "The others can do it, while I slack off for now." No team rises to the pinnacle of success with members who have selfish attitudes.

In Sura 48:11, such persons, also called slackers, are characterized as those who "lagged behind:"

Those of the dwellers of the desert who lagged behind will say to thee: Our property and our families kept us busy, so ask forgiveness for us. They say with their tongues what is not in their hearts. Say: Then who can control aught for you from Allah, if He intends to do you harm or if He intends to do you good. Nay, Allah is ever Aware of what you do.

The nature of the "We" requires all team members to "come through," "show up," and "just do it." Excuses are unacceptable.

Notwithstanding, Allah, the Originator, is not dependent on anyone. HE is Independent. HIS Plan is never frustrated, nor does HE fail. HE can easily force us to submit to HIS Will. HE can also bring forth other people to replace the persons or "souls" that, for whatever reason, refuse to accept their destiny. In Sura 47:38, Allah states:

Behold! You are those who are called to spend in Allah's way, but among you are those who are niggardly; and whoever is niggardly, is niggardly against his own soul. And Allah is Self-Sufficient and you are needy. And, if you turn back He Will bring in your place another people, then they Will not be like you.

Believers, in general, are required to spend their lives in the Way of Allah. However, those persons predestined for the highest levels of divine leadership are required to make sacrifices far beyond what could be considered "reasonable" service. They are required to make "super" sacrifices, functioning outside of what is considered a normal life. This epitomizes the Domestic Life, because It is a 'Life" that involves extraordinary sacrifice.

In Sura 51:2, these persons are called “those bearing the load.” Commentators on this verse describe them as “clouds” that carry “rain”—eventually pouring rain on land in need of life. This suggests that their responsibilities involve the transference of divine knowledge that enables humanity to advance the Originator’s Goal for the Perfection of human life.

Bearing this “load” requires extraordinary focus, attention to detail, intuition and foresight. Only complete immersion into their function will make them successful. Again, total sacrifice of “self” is absolutely necessary for success. However, Allah’s “peace” is on them despite the arduous lifelong commitment required of them. How so?

The Originator brought from HIMSELF the first “Soul Mate,” as HE, HIMSELF, is the quintessential Soul or Divine Being. Again, HE never existed as a formless and immaterial spirit. Therefore, the soul is not formless, lacking aim and purpose; yet it transcends the human or physical form of our bodies.

Throughout the Holy Quran, “soul” is used more than “person.” This substantiates the truth that we are “divine beings” in human form. In Sura 6:164, it states:

Say: Shall I seek a Lord other than Allah, while He is the Lord of all things? And no soul earns (evil) but against itself. Nor does a bearer of burden bear another’s burden. Then to your Lord is your return, so He will inform you of that in which you differed.

As the “Soul Mate” of the Originator, the Woman brings through Her womb other “soul mates”—a concept that is far deeper than the popular definitions of this concept. People usually think of “soul mate” as a particular person (spouse) they were/are predestined to marry. This definition only partially aligns with the “team” analogy previously discussed.

According to Sura 30:21, Allah joins man and woman, soul mates, in matrimony:

And of His signs is this, that He created mates for you from yourselves that you might find quiet of mind in them, and He put between you love and compassion. Surely there are signs in this for a people who reflect.

In Sura 24:33, Allah declares that HE will give to each of us our soul mate:

And let those who cannot find a match keep chaste, until Allah makes them free from want out of His grace...

There is, however, a richer context of “soul mate.” A renowned clairvoyant exquisitely explains this particular concept of “soul mate”:

Those of any sect or group where there is the answering of one to another; as would be the tongue to the groove, the tenon to the mortise; or in any such where they are a complement one of another—that is what is meant by “soul-mate.” Not that as from physical attraction, but from the mental and spiritual help.¹

The use of the phrase, “sect or group” to define soul mate, in the context of the service or help they provide to one another transcends physical or sexual intimacy between two persons—man and woman. It is also beyond individualism, while supporting the “individual” as part of the “sect or group,” or team.

To understand “Soul” is to understand ourselves. This satanic world, through mis-education, disallows most people the opportunity to go deep enough into themselves to feel their souls. Because we suffer mental and spiritual death living under the influence and control of the satanic leaders, most people never become acquainted with the best part of themselves. The horrific state of this world proves this.

“Soul,” by its very nature, is also Divine. “Soul,” by its very nature, is Love. Hence, we are divine beings in human form rather than human beings—especially given that human (humus) also means Earth. The “divine” attributes in our nature must, however, be brought forth from each of us. This also makes “Divine Love,” which is rooted in the nature of the Originator, the only love there is.

The phrase “the answering of one to another” is the nature of the “relationship” among these souls or persons. This is diverse and multi-faceted; and as such involves far more than sexual intimacy.

It depends on what each soul requires to fulfill its purpose on behalf of the group, in their unified mission.

Even as it relates to sexual intimacy or mating to produce offspring, the “help” is still of a mental and spiritual nature. There is an exchange of the mental and spiritual treasures between husband and wife to ensure that they bring forth the best children possible and/or pursue their predestined work. Both involve the Science of Mating.

Let us consider the analogous phrase, “tenon to the mortise.” For thousands of years, tenons (tongue) and mortises (holes) have been used in woodworking as the basis of structures. The concept is similar to fitting a square block perfectly into a square hole to bond the two together.

The mortise and tenon joins woodworking pieces together at 90° angles. A square contains four 90° angles. The tenon is “precisely” cut to fit the mortise hole or entrance; consequently, forming and stabilizing the structure.



Conceptually, as it relates to soul mates, the “tenon to the mortise” involves the joining and rejoining of souls—not only in a “complementary” sense, but also to build the spiritual structure to support the function to which these souls were called forth. They are bonded together, in the same fashion as the materials used to construct any edifice that is expected to have utility, durability and longevity.

The 90° angle, which can only be formed by two straight lines, is also called a “right angle.” This indicates the group’s uprightness and the stability of their upward and forward motion in doing the work assigned to them. As it relates to the establishment of

Allah's Eternal Kingdom of Peace, the vertical and horizontal lines forming the "right angle" extend to infinity, representing what is known as the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:10:

Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

The harmony between Heaven and Earth is geometrically represented through their unified labor.

Each soul contains multiple mortises and tenons, and is part of a sphere of commensal and communal activity with other souls. This is manifested on a physical plane through blood-relationships, marriage-ties and friendships. Souls provide and receive mental and spiritual assistance to produce personal and interpersonal harmony and perfection. Through these dynamics, we experience the highest degree of solace that enables us to bear the increasing load of our individual roles and "collective" functions. This, no doubt, is the "ideal."

On this Earthly Plane, soul mates are usually unfamiliar with each other until circumstances bring them together. This is a natural phenomenon. Our unions are divine, and are always bridged at the spiritual level, whether we realize this. A prime example is the relationship between Believers and the Messenger (Messiah), as well as with Believers among themselves.

We also must consider Allah's control over souls. HE has the ability to bond souls; thereby creating a single "soulful entity" manifested through various hearts and minds.

DOMESTIC LIFE IN DIVINE GOVERNANCE

Fundamentally, we are all part of the Originator's Domestic Life—according to the Bible and Holy Quran. This was addressed in the previous Chapter. The Supreme Being's Domestic Life directly involves the Spiritual Line of Universal Leadership and Governance. This is the highest manifestation of the Originator's Domestic Life. Again, this involves the 24 Holy Wise Scientists, who decide, plan and govern the events that occur on our Planet. They have been doing this for trillions of years. However, others are also involved in the Supreme Being's Domestic Life. This aspect is discussed later in this Chapter.

Why is Divine Governance, as a major aspect of the Domestic Life, necessary? Seven billion people cannot decide and orchestrate

events governing the Earth and Universe. This, however, does not make their lives less important than those preordained to serve at the highest level. This is simply not their responsibility. They have other responsibilities.

Most people assume that the current rulers, the Caucasian people, of this divinely-condemned world decide what takes place on Earth. This is an incorrect assumption. This world, and the nations that comprise it, exists within the framework of this 6,000-year vacuum in the Original People's History, which was envisioned by the 24 Holy Wise Scientists approximately 15,000 years ago—at the beginning of this 25,000-year cycle. This 6,000-year period ended in 1914. In Sura 3:196-197, Allah states:

196) Let not control in the land, of those who disbelieve, deceive thee. 197) A brief enjoyment! Then their abode is hell. And evil is the resting-place.

The Bible also affirms that the Caucasian people's world was planned, from the beginning to the end. The Book of Revelation encapsulates their brief tenure as the rulers of the Earth, causing mischief and bloodshed.

Notwithstanding, the Messiah has offered the leaders of the nations throughout the Earth a chance to comply with the Supreme Being's Will. Although their fate is described in the Scriptures—specifically in Psalm 110—they can escape Allah's wrath, if they decide to heed His warning and accept His guidance.

The Originator's desire to Perfect Himself is at the Foundation of the Domestic Life, which produces and prepares people destined to invoke and facilitate events and circumstances that advance this Goal. This is substantiated throughout the Bible in the stories of the prophets' personal lives—particularly, Abraham, Lot, Moses and David.

The Holy Quran also affirms the importance of the Domestic Life in the many verses that pertain to "Muhammad's" private life. For example, in Sura 13:38, Allah states:

And certainly We sent messengers before thee and appointed for them wives and children. And it is not in (the power of) a messenger to bring a sign except by Allah's permission. For every term there is an appointment.

In Sura 33, Allah expresses the value and importance of the wives of "Muhammad." In verse 34, Allah states:

And remember that which is recited in your houses of the messages of Allah and the Wisdom. Surely Allah is ever Knower of subtleties, Aware.

This bears on the responsibilities of Muhammad's wives regarding the Divine Message, and consequently, the destiny of humanity.

Today, Divine Governance through the Domestic Life applies to Master Fard Muhammad, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Honorable Louis Farrakhan and, generally, the Original People of the Western Hemisphere. As previously discussed, Master Fard Muhammad is the Fulfillment and Manifestation of the Originator's Goal for Perfection. We live in the Eternal Realm of HIS Rule and Plan to produce a New Heaven and Earth, as well as a New People—as prophesied in the Scriptures. In Revelation 21:5, it states:

And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new.

Also, in First John 3:2, it states:

Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

The Holy Quran describes Allah's Plan to produce a new creation. In Sura 50:15, Allah states:

Were We then fatigued with the first creation? Yet they are in doubt about a new creation.

Regarding Allah's Plan to make new human beings, in Sura 56:35-40, it states:

35) Surely We have created them a (new) creation, 36) So We have made them virgins, 37) Loving, equals in age, 38) For those on the right hand. 39) A multitude from among the first, 40) And a multitude from among those of later times.

Before the Coming of Master Fard Muhammad, the Holy Wise Scientists, who wrote the History, kept the true Knowledge of the Reality of God among themselves, handing it from father to son. Again, this has occurred for trillions of years. Master Fard Muhammad is now producing a Nation of Gods through HIS Great Mahdi and

Messiah—the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and the Honorable Louis Farrakhan, respectively. HE is starting with HIS Chosen People, the Black People of the Western Hemisphere, in fulfillment of the Messianic Prophecies of the Bible and Holy Quran.

For most people today, their awareness of the Domestic Life comes from the little they know of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad's private life. However, Master Fard Muhammad's birth is borne of the Domestic Life.

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad taught us that Master Fard Muhammad has a Black father and a Caucasian mother. HIS Father is in the Circle of the 24 Holy Wise Scientists; and HIS mother is of the lineage of Prophet Muhammad. She is from the Islamic communities in the Caucasus Mountains Region.

The knowledge of the dynamics it took to produce Master Fard Muhammad is vital to our growth in understanding the Domestic Life. HIS mother, father and the Holy Wise Scientists had major roles in HIS development into the Most Powerful Person or God who ever lived and will ever live. HIS mother's role involves the "Secret of God;" and acquiring this understanding imbues us with the deepest knowledge of the "Science of Mating." Let us consider the following from Mother Tynetta Muhammad:

Why did the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad teach us that a Man cannot attain his full Wisdom without the Woman? Does this have anything to do with the Knowledge of God being kept as a secret in a small circle of god-scientists in the beginning? They were all born of a Woman and were raised and taught by their mothers, which is the very nature of children in relationship to their mothers until they mature and take hold to the responsibilities of their Manhood and God-hood.²

As indicated, the mother's role is critical to the process of making "Supreme Beings." This affirms that the Science of Mating extends from the natural "desire" or "necessity" to produce offspring and continues through the maturation of that child, male or female, in taking hold of its responsibilities of adulthood and God-hood.

What then is the Domestic Life beyond Master Fard Muhammad's birth and the nurturing HE received from HIS Mother? How does Master Fard Muhammad extend HIS Domestic Life to the lives of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Honorable Louis Farrakhan, and the Original People of the Western Hemisphere?

At this point, the Domestic Life is an "Environment" that Master Fard Muhammad produced to advance the spiritual, mental and physical development of HIS Mahdi and Messiah—for the effective execution of Their responsibilities and growth into the divine power predetermined for Them.

This "Environment" is uniquely framed by women. In basic terms, the Domestic Life is polygamous marriages. There are stark "emotional" realities associated with this. As such, some people might ask the following questions:

- Why is more than one wife required?
- Would not polygamy lead to domestic problems that hinder the success of the Divine Work?"

These are legitimate questions. Allah holds the complete answer to the first question since HE is the Orchestrator of the Domestic Life. Notwithstanding, the Domestic Life is essential in developing the leadership qualities of the women involved. The Bible and Holy Quran provide insight into the value of the work of the wives of several prophets, such as Abraham, David, and Jesus.

Allah has determined the "seed" of the Messiah to be of extraordinary value. Through the Domestic Life, offspring of significant consequence is produced to advance the Messianic Mission.

As for the second question, numerous anthropological studies on polygamy delineate the struggles associated with polygamous marriages. "Struggle" is inherent in any marriage. In addition, the "low" state of the humanity resulting from living in this satanic world has caused most people to misunderstand the value of marriage.

Some anthropological research suggests that "co-wives" rival one another for household resources and for the husband's attention; while other research shows that co-wives form close relationships among themselves that benefit everyone involved in the marriage. Both experiences hinge on the way or manner in which the

“marriage” is established. This affects how the marriage is sustained. How so?

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad teaches that the way a “thing” comes into existence determines its nature. The more that our marriages are borne of the Originator’s Aim, the greater the chance our marriages will be successful regardless of the challenging circumstances.

A higher understanding of the Domestic Life unearths the value of marriage in achieving Allah’s Goal for the Perfection of Creation. This effort requires overcoming personal discomforts to focus on the “bigger picture”—which is the purpose for the Domestic Life.

The success of polygamy rests with each person’s understanding of marriages—that is, the purpose of, and the expected benefits and challenges associated with marriage. This knowledge bears on their ability to mitigate and resolve the problems that arise in the marriage. They will be able to depend on each other to sustain and improve the marriage; and to accomplish the goals of the marriage. This requires cooperation among everyone, even extending to the children.

Ideally, all members of the Domestic Life will consider themselves part of one family—the Supreme Being’s Family. Although each husband-wife relationship is critical to achieving personal satisfaction in the marital union, it is not driven or sustained by attitudes of selfishness and covetousness. Coherence is ultimately achieved.

Regarding the number of women selected as wives of the Messiah, Master Fard Muhammad knows what is required to achieve HIS purpose. All persons involved were predestined to serve in the Messianic Mission in this way; therefore, their specific marital unions preexisted in Allah’s Plan. They were divinely “programmed” for success. This is explained in Romans 8:28-30:

- 28) And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. 29) For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. 30) Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he

called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

As previously stated, the formation of the Domestic Life for service to humanity is analogous to the Originator's Self-Creation, in that HE is summoning up part of HIMSELF by calling forward those involved in the execution of the Divine Function predestined of them.

They did not make themselves. They are not responsible for who they are. They are "justified" when they learn of, accept and apply themselves to their predetermined and lifelong responsibility. They are "honored" through the glorification of Allah by fulfilling their Divine Function.

The above verses from the Book of Romans is an inspiring truth that each person involved in the Domestic Life must embrace. Additional realities are involved in this. Let us consider several of them.

One reality is that the Messiah and HIS Wives were all predestined to be together even though specific marital unions occurred at various points in time. Therefore, while the marital union between the Messiah and His first wife may have occurred decades before the other marital unions, all of them were predestined to take place. Allah orchestrated the entire process long before they were born.

Another reality is that the success of the Divine Work that the Messiah and HIS Wives were created to do is predicated on the acceptance of this truth, which is the acceptance of their rightful place in Allah's Plan. Why is it important that they understand this? Two points should be considered.

First, is the notion of "free will"—does it exist when our lives are predetermined? None of us are born to whimsically "do our own thing," in the colloquial sense of the phrase. The fact that none of us had anything to do with our births also means that we had nothing to do with determining our purpose for having been born. We are born knowing nothing, including the purpose for which we were born. In Sura 16:78, Allah states:

And Allah brought you forth from the wombs of your mothers—you knew nothing—and He gave you hearing and sight and hearts that you might give thanks.

The Originator brought us forth; therefore, HE knows why each of us were born. Each of us must discover and then accept that specific purpose, if we are to get the greatest value from our lives. Our greatest treasure is in knowing our purpose in this life despite the challenges involved in fulfilling that purpose. We are then “free” to act within Allah’s Will for our lives.

Second, understanding that everyone involved in the Domestic Life was predestined for the Messianic Mission, ideally, insulates each person from insecurity. How so? Each person can faithfully accept and embrace Allah’s View of the other. Again, their predestination is at the Originator’s Self-Creation.

The Messianic Mission is consecrated in the Originator’s Goal for Perfection and the Establishment of the Eternal Kingdom of Peace. This Mission includes the Coming of Allah in Person among HIS Chosen People to raise the Great Mahdi and Messiah from among them to redeem them.

This understanding elevates the minds of those involved in the Domestic Life into the most matured way of thinking, which is the “Thinking of God.” Ideally, this makes their predestined “function” the foremost priority in their lives. Their respect and love for each other also deepens; and the desire to fulfill their collective purpose intensifies.

Each person in the Domestic Life manifests the sentiment that “they would climb a mountain 40 miles high” to ensure that the marital unions and the ties of relationship from such unions are sustained and strengthened because the success of the Messianic Mission is at stake. There is much more to this. This is the basis of genius. Mother Tynetta Muhammad states:

What is the condition that produces genius? It is brought about by the intensity of thought and action to achieve an objective that is greater than one’s self and which emanates to embrace the whole of humanity guiding us to an evolutionary step that leads to perfection.

Always, life is sacrificed in this process. Things don’t just happen by chance or accident. We are all born with purpose and

meaning and it is our environment that molds and shapes us in fulfilling our destiny.³

The propensity toward cooperation and the deep-seated desire to be successful are rooted in one's faith in the "Orchestrator" of the Domestic Life—Allah, in the Person of Master Fard Muhammad. Indeed, the fact that HE arranged the marital unions is the most critical and distinguishing factor.

Therefore, the often-repeated "crescendo" in the marriage vow (Mark 10:9): "What therefore God has joined together, let no man put asunder," is an objective in the Domestic Life. Allah brought them together. This fact cannot be emphasized enough; and being mindful of this foundational truth is the balm that heals the pain of the struggles intrinsic to the Domestic Life. It also enables them to endure the perpetual challenges of the Journey. Allah must remain at the very core of the marriage.

Despite their acceptance of the truth associated with the Domestic Life—specifically, that they were predestined—the challenge of wrapping their minds around these realities yet exist. Gaining comfort with acceptance occurs gradually and involves significant contemplation. It requires them to examine their lives in as much detail as possible, and going as far back as possible. They need to trace the "footprints" and "connect the dots," which substantiate the truth of this Grand Reality in their lives. These connections fuel self-realization; thereby, enabling them to gain the confidence required to truly accept and embrace their destiny. There is yet more.

Self-realization involves deep internal analysis of the activities in one's life. Accepting one's self can be challenging, especially when learning that one's function is of a divine nature and is beyond what he/she could have ever imagined. How difficult is this to accept, especially for people who have been made to believe that they are nothing in their own eyes, as a result of living under the rule of their mortal enemies? Eliminating the mind of "Black inferiority" is a major challenge. How so?

The Black People of America, in particular, have been made to hate themselves, and our commitment to religious worship has not overcome the social systems that drive self-hatred and self-abnegation (negation) down our throats. Therefore, it is always easier to believe the sentiment: "I can't be that important to Allah. It should be someone else because it can't be me." These are among many of the negative sentiments harboring in the minds of the Original People of the Western Hemisphere.

This reality bears on the seemingly "slowness" of the spiritual and mental resurrection of the Original People of the Western Hemisphere from gross ignorance and fear of their mortal enemies. Allah has allocated time for us to accept the knowledge of who we are—which is, direct descendants of the Originator. This also includes the time required to overcome self-destructive behaviors that have become comfort zones for most of us.

The underlying challenge of the Black People of America, in particular, is the fear of being something more than what our mortal enemies, the Caucasian people, told us we were. In their eyes, the Original People are commodities meant to be used, abused, enslaved and destroyed. We have been under these oppressive and false concepts for centuries.

Consequently, although many Black people aspire to greatness, we perceive greatness from the limited eyes of our mortal enemies. Our greatness, according to them, is defined by how "great" we serve them in keeping this divinely-condemned world afloat.

The greatness that Allah has destined for the Original People of the Western Hemisphere is to make us builders of HIS Eternal Kingdom—yet for many of us, this is the least sought objective in our lives. Wise people ponder over this negative mentality. In Sura 71:13-14, Allah states:

- 13) What is the matter with you that you hope not for greatness from Allah? 14) And indeed He has created you by various stages.

Consequently, the fear of embracing the greatness that Allah has conferred on the Original People of the Western Hemisphere gives rise to the unnatural behavior to "stay in our place" as "nothing," according to the wishes of our open enemies. We fight against one another to maintain this warped perception of life. This is bizarre;

nevertheless, it remains the norm for Black People. What is this mindset tied to?

The Black People of America's experience with disappointment—caused by our enemies' gross abuse of us—is so much a part of life in the Western Hemisphere that when disappointment is not present, we drum up obstacles that set us back. We self-implode despite knowing that our unity is required if we are to succeed. It is as if we need to be "in touch" with failure, dejection and abuse to feel "at home." Unfortunately, this is our comfort zone; and it is continuously reinforced by the government systems and despicable culture of the Caucasian people.

Self-abnegation is also the result of a tainted perception about life. This satanic world makes people self-centered, selfish, and arrogant; and as such, we incline to perceive "I," instead of "We." The "I" is not the reality; the "We" is. Negative attitudes, such as self-abnegation, self-effacement and low self-esteem are associated with the concept of "I"—in a way that, conceptually, disconnects us from the Originator and HIS Creation.

The "We" is ubiquitous throughout the Holy Quran, yet it represents the Unity and Oneness, and not the plurality, of Allah. For example, in Sura 15:9, Allah states:

Surely We have revealed the Reminder, and surely We are its
Guardian.

In Sura 40:78, Allah also states:

And certainly We sent messengers before thee—of them are
those We have mentioned to thee and of them are those We
have not mentioned to thee.

Who is the "We"? In its broadest sense, the "We" is all the men and women who lent their minds to improve life in the Universe since the Originator's Self-Creation. At the root, the "We" is Allah, because each one submits to expressing and representing HIS Will.

Being aware of one's dependency on Allah makes self-realization straightforward because Allah is not outside of the "Self." HE is in the "Self"—in each human being. Ultimately, an understanding of "Self" is an understanding of "We." This logic releases the strain produced by false concepts based on individualism, which fosters ingratitude and destructive behaviors in this world.

Through a better understanding of our relationship with Allah, we are able to overcome the self-defeating mentalities that plague us. True gratitude to Allah can then be established in our hearts. Eventually, Allah blesses us to get to this lofty point because HE understands everything about us. HE is the Patient, the Merciful.

DOMESTIC LIFE IN NATIONAL LIFE

Revelation 4:4 mentions the 24 Holy Wise Scientists, who are referred to as “Elders” in this verse:

And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

In Sura 37:8, they are called the “Exalted Assembly”:

They cannot listen to the exalted assembly and they are reproached from every side...

They are also the owners of the “Elevated Places” mentioned in Sura 7:48:

And the owners of the Elevated Places call out to men whom they recognize by their marks, saying: Of no avail were to you your amassings and your arrogance.

According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the 24 Holy Wise Scientists are divided into two groups of 12—that is, 12 Major and 12 Minor.⁴ The 12 Major Scientists are/were tasked with revealing the “scripts” or “scriptures” from the “Planned 25,000-year History” to those persons commissioned to warn and guide the people to whom they are/were sent.

In Problem 32 of The Problem Book, in The Supreme Wisdom given by Master Fard Muhammad to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad during the early 1930s, it states:

Twelve Leaders of Islam from all over the Planet have conferred in the Root of Civilization concerning the Lost-Found Nation of Islam—must return to their original Land.

One of the Conference Members by the name of Mr. Osman Sharrief said to the Eleven Members of the Conference:

“The Lost-Found Nation of Islam Will not return to their original Land unless they, first, have a thorough Knowledge of their own.”

So they sent a Messenger to them of their own.

This has very rich meaning. The point intended here, as it relates to the subject of this Chapter, is that the Holy Wise Scientists govern the Universe, and as such, convened among Themselves about the survival and future of the Black People of the Western Hemisphere. This shows that great investment was and is involved in their destiny, despite the belief among the nations of the Earth that Black People in the Western Hemisphere have no value.

The nations of the Earth, especially the United States, are increasingly learning that Allah has not forsaken the Original People in the Western Hemisphere. HE is demonstrating HIS Love for them through HIS chastisement of the nations of the Earth.

As indicated in Problem 32, the Black People of the Western Hemisphere, the Lost-Found Nation of Islam, cannot return to their “original Land” until they have a thorough knowledge of their own. They must be reformed and cultivated to the point where they are fit to be placed on top of civilization. The “Land” refers to their true “nature,” as well as to their rulership over the Earth, which is now underway through the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and the Honorable Louis Farrakhan.

Throughout The Problem Book, Master Fard Muhammad informs us that we, the Lost-Found Nation of Islam, are 1) living other than ourselves; 2) lack the knowledge of “self”; and 3) lack the knowledge of “others” than “self.” These things are at the root of our physical, mental, spiritual and moral degeneration (death). After spending nearly 500 years under various forms of slavery, this atrocious condition should come as no surprise. The Black People of the Western Hemisphere were “reared” by brute beasts (Caucasian people), who now masquerade themselves as authorities on human life.

According to Problem 32, the One sent by the 12 Leaders of Islam provides us with a thorough knowledge of our own. What we are now learning about the Originator’s Self-Creation from the Honorable Elijah Muhammad is part of this Body of Knowledge. Even in this, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad called this aspect of His

Teachings “a wake up message”—indicating that Greater Knowledge is forthcoming. Notwithstanding, this Seminal Knowledge is sufficient to place the Lost-Found Nation of Islam above the top scholarship of this satanic world, which Master Fard Muhammad called a “wilderness” and “hell.”

Although Master Fard Muhammad made His Presence known to us in 1930, in Detroit, and established the Nation of Islam in the West, the “One” sent to us was the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, and not Master Fard Muhammad, The Supreme Being, Allah in Person. The phrase, “So they sent a Messenger to them of their own” substantiates this.

According to the Bible and Holy Quran, when Allah intends to warn and guide a town or people who act against HIS Will, HE raises from among that town or people a person who makes HIS Will known. This person, called a prophet or messenger, is responsible for delivering the divine message of warning and guidance within a predesignated timeframe. In Sura 62:2, Allah states:

He it is Who raised among the illiterates a Messenger from among themselves, who recites to them His messages and purifies them, and teaches them the Book and the Wisdom—although they were before certainly in Manifest error—

“Illiterate,” in this case, means a person who is not trained by the so-called higher institutions of this world. According to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, Allah never sent a messenger “degreed” or “lettered” by the satanic institutions he was sent to condemn and eliminate. This would not make sense. Moreover, this is why those who brandish “higher learning” certificates are inclined to reject Allah’s messengers, because of the high status they hold among the people. Consequently, most of them are too proud to accept the truth from someone whom they consider “unlearned.”

Why does Allah raise HIS messengers from among the very people HE intends to warn and guide? Among several reasons is that the messenger or prophet is closer to the social condition of that people. He was in the mud with them. By being from among the people, he knows how to convey the divine message in a manner that they will understand.

In addition, prior to a divine messenger’s commission as a “messenger,” he has the desire to see the horrible social plight among

the people eliminated. This is affirmed throughout the Holy Quran and Bible. The messenger knows that the people, which includes his family, have the ability to change. He also has the ideas and plan—given to him by Allah—to advance the society or civilization. Allah opens him up, and then guides him into the realization of these and other ideas rooted in the HIS Will.

When Allah takes a person from among the people, and then purifies, elevates and stands that person before the people as proof of HIS divine intervention in their affairs, HE is showing them that they have the potential to change their attitudes and behaviors. Allah makes HIS messenger the example for the people to follow.

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad was and is one of the “Lost-Founds” whom Master Fard Muhammad raised to HIMSELF and then sent Him to serve as a Messenger to the Lost-Found Nation of Islam. When we consider that the Honorable Elijah Muhammad spent approximately three and one-half years, day and night, with Master Fard Muhammad, merely saying that He met face-to-face with Allah, the Supreme Being, is an understatement.

In light of this, we must consider the fact that the Honorable Elijah Muhammad was far more than a Messenger, even at that time. He referred to Himself as the Last Messenger of Allah, which relates to the function of Mahdi and Messiah. How so?

In Sura 3, the Messiah is made a “messenger” to the Lost Sheep, the Children of Israel. Verses 45 and 49 describes this:

45) When the angels said: O Mary, surely Allah gives thee good news with a word from Him (of one) whose name is the Messiah, Jesus, son of Mary, worthy of regard in this world and the Hereafter, and of those who are drawn nigh (to Allah)...49) And (make him) a messenger to the Children of Israel (saying): I have come to you with a sign from your Lord, that I determine for you out of dust the form of a bird, then I breathe into it and it becomes a bird with Allah's permission, and I heal the blind and the leprous, and bring the dead to life with Allah's permission; and I inform you of what you should eat and what you should store in your houses. Surely there is a sign in this for you, if you are believers.

This indicates that the Messiah functions as a divine messenger responsible for guiding the Original People of the Western Hemisphere into the ways of Allah through the divine knowledge He teaches them. The Messiah appears during the prophesied Messianic Era, which begins in the Last Days of the rulership of the Caucasian people over the Earth's inhabitants.

The Messianic Era began in 1930 when Master Fard Muhammad made HIMSELF known to us. This is established in Point 12 of What The Muslims Believe, in the Muslim Program:

WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of the Muslims.

We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no god and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace together.

This "universal government of peace" is being realized through the work of the Great Mahdi and Messiah—the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and the Honorable Louis Farrakhan, respectively. Isaiah 9:6 affirms that Allah in Person (Mighty God), the Great Mahdi (Everlasting Father) and the Messiah (Prince of Peace) are bearing the Eternal Government of Peace:

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Once the Messianic Era begins, the Messiah is present. However, the function of the Messiah evolves over time; and it involves gathering, redeeming and delivering a scattered and oppressed people, Allah's Chosen People. These objectives are realized on spiritual, mental and physical levels. As such, they are achieved over a long-term process—again, involving many generations.

The divine message of guidance and warning is at the helm of this process. Therefore, the nature of the work of the Great Mahdi and Messiah makes Them Messengers, as well.

Master Fard Muhammad is gathering HIS People into HIS Family through the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and the Honorable Louis Farrakhan. What does Master Fard Muhammad have in mind by

doing this? What does this “gathering” entail? Let us consider the following from Jabril Muhammad:

Messenger Muhammad teaches that Master Fard Muhammad aims to raise the Lost-Found (so-called Negro) into the knowledge and wisdom—the very ideas—of the Gods of the past. And this is not all. The Messenger goes on to say that He also aims presently, to raise His people into His own ideas, in Himself, that the scriptures may be fulfilled: that those to whom He reveals Himself become the sons (and the daughters) of God...sons and daughters in the wisdom of God. (See first chapter of John.)

This is not, nor could it be the end of the process. The New Testament speaks of God’s chosen as receiving new bodies. (This naturally includes the brains.) He aims not only to reveal His ideas for the present creation of the universe, but also to give to man the nature and the creative wisdom to produce creative ideas as The Father of Civilization. This is what was prophesied: that God would make man like Himself. He aims to make The Nation of Righteousness, who will rule in the Hereafter, with the potential knowledge of producing and bringing into action, or existence, that which He has been able to produce. We call this “ideas.” He aims to make each one into a God.⁵

What does this process involve? The Domestic Life has had and will continue to have a major role in this process, because the “woman” is a key exponent of this process. This makes absolute sense given that she produces the human populations. The destiny of the Chosen People lies in the elevation of women.

Given that Master Fard Muhammad, the Supreme Being, has chosen the Black People of America to be the Foundation of HIS Eternal Kingdom, matrimonial unions are continuously arranged among Members of the Lost-Found Nation of Islam to necessitate, facilitate, and manage the end-to-end process—from the “gathering” through the “return to our original Land.” Allah arranges many of these marriages unbeknown to us. In Sura 24:33, Allah states:

And let those who cannot find a match keep chaste, until Allah makes them free from want out of His grace.

Those who have waited on Allah to bless them with their mates, may be able to declare that HE arranged their marriages. We can affirm this by analyzing the circumstances involving our marital unions. We should be able to recognize Allah's Hand in them. Why would Allah arrange marriages?

Redemption is not an instant event or overnight process. Countless generations will be involved before this objective is fully realized, which also includes the making of "Perfect Rulers." As the Lost-Found Nation of Islam progresses toward reclaiming our "own," while moving away from the clumsy, careless, ignorant and immoral culture heaped on us by the Caucasian people, "arranged" marriages will have a greater role in the National Life of the Nation of Islam in the West.

The reasons for this are critical to the survival of the Original People of the Western Hemisphere, in particular; and to their destiny as Saviors of humanity. As it relates to the Original People's survival, Black women of the Western Hemisphere must be protected and secured. Today, many people might perceive these objectives as near impossible feats because the predators and abusers of Black women are ubiquitous, and now include "criminal organizations" that are indirectly and directly supported by national and international government institutions.

As a result, Black women are continuously preyed upon, assaulted, and even forced into prostitution by men of different nationalities. Many Black men are also vehemently terrorizing their own women. Today, the lives of girls as young as ten years old are being ruined because girls and women are no longer perceived as anything more than commodities—items for trade and commerce.

Because of the horrific treatment of women, Allah is severely chastising the male population. HIS chastisement, combined with the decimation of the Black male population by the U.S. Government and Caucasian people, has led to fewer and fewer Black men. This has produced problematic disparities in the number of Black men compared to Black women. What is the resolution to this problem?

The Domestic Life of Master Fard Muhammad is the solution. Polygamy, therefore, will one day have a role in producing a moral and

safe society. This is the reality, and our understanding of the Domestic Life—especially as it relates to the value and role of women—is requisite in getting the Original People of the Western Hemisphere through the arduous process of salvation and redemption.

In the perpetual building of the Kingdom of Allah, children of consequence must be produced. These children must possess advanced potential for mental and spiritual development. This deliberate process hinges on the value of arranged marriages, and a profound understanding of the “Science of Mating.”

This, no doubt, means that Allah’s imposition on the Lost-Found Nation of Islam will continue to increase. HE will gradually require us to transcend “comfort zones” and to sacrifice individualism for the realization of HIS Eternal Kingdom. HE requires us to rise above emotion into HIS thinking, if we to be a part of HIS Success.

Understandably, this will be a significant challenge for many members of the Lost-Found Nation of Islam, for many years to come. Why? We are steep in the immoral and frivolous culture of this evil world. In this world, fornication, adultery and sexual deviant behaviors are encouraged, promoted, glorified and legally protected. When we become Believers in Allah and HIS Messiah, we are introduced to the Laws of God, which forbid immoral behavior. For some people, obeying these Divine Laws is a constant struggle.

Equally as disruptive is that many of the members of the Lost-Found Nation of Islam, who claim belief in God through Christianity, also maintain the false concepts given to them by the satanic leaders of this world. Most people have embraced these wicked concepts about life, love, family and relationships. They also accept the standards of this immoral world. By doing this, such persons are attempting to serve two masters, which cannot be done; therefore, they end up serving the satanic leaders of this world.

Furthermore, in this world—whether we are married or have intimate relationships outside of wedlock—we have the freedom to select our own “mates.” Many of us may have experienced occasions where other people have spoken in opposition to our selection or choice of a potential spouse or mate, or “friend.” Most of us did not take kindly to someone telling us with whom we should or should not be intimately involved.

Because of this mindset, most people cannot fathom having someone else select their spouses. When we consider that marriage is a lifelong commitment, the prospect of someone requiring a person to marry someone not of his/her choosing seems absurd, yet this is a reality in the Domestic Life. In Sura 33:36, Allah states:

And it behooves not a believing Man or a believing Woman, when Allah and His Messenger have decided an affair, to exercise a choice in their matter. And whoever disobeys Allah and His Messenger, he surely strays off to Manifest error.

This makes it clear that believers in Allah and HIS Messiah are required to obey Him in this regard. Our acceptance of this reality will ultimately determine the quality and length of our service to Allah.

The realization that aspects of polygamy will one day become a reality in the National Life of the Lost-Found Nation of Islam requires everyone to be thoroughly educated in the Thinking of Allah, as it relates to the knowledge of the Domestic Life; and its value in establishing Allah's Eternal Kingdom.
