Mike was honored as the first whistleblower "Lawyer of the Year" by Taxpayers Against Fraud, a national organization of whistleblowers and their counsel. He also represented the pharmacist in cases alleging that Johnson & Johnson paid kickbacks to influence drug selections in Omnicare's nursing homes, which recovered over \$170 million. In another major case, Mike represented the relators in a 16-year battle involving the B-2 "Stealth" bomber and other military programs, which resulted in Northrop Grumman paying \$134 million. Before entering private practice, Mike served as a prosecutor with the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York (securities and futures fraud unit), as a trial attorney for the Commodity Futures Trading Commission, and as a Judicial Clerk in the U.S. District Court for Vermont. He is a graduate of Dartmouth College and Northeastern University School of Law (in Boston).
