Permit-required confined spaces can present conditions that are immediately dangerous to workers' lives or health if not properly identified, evaluated, tested and controlled. When is a certified on-site standby rescue team required?

- When the facility owner's policy or project spec requires the presence of a rescue team.
- When off-site rescue services cannot respond in a timely manner.
- When off-site rescue services are not equipped for/proficient in the rescue services required.
- The confined space exhibits an IDLH hazard.
- The confined space entry requires supplied air (SCBA or inline air).
- When a non-entry rescue attempt has failed.
